



Children's Playmates toy intercom

Quick instructions

1. Familiar with this machine



Serial number	Name	Operation Instructions
01	Launch key	press the "PTT launch key" one second after the start of speech, talk over release the "PTT launch key"
02	Side Key One	2.Standby interface, short press for "Volume +". After entering the menu, short press up.
03	Side Key Two	Standby interface, short press for "Volume -". After entering the menu, short press down
04	Function Keys	Standby interface, the short press to enter the menu. Enter the menu for the Ok Key.
05	Shortcut keys	Short Press to enter member selection interface Long Press Lock Screen/unlock
06	Power Key	In standby state, press the short breath screen, press the long switch, enter the menu for the return key.
07	Indicator Light	Red light is always on at launch, green light is always on at reception, red light is always on at charging, green light is on to indicate full charge
08	Microphone	Microphone 3-5cm away from the mouth the best voice quality
09	Charging Port	Charge, data, headphone three in one TYPE-C interface.

2. Basic operation

- 1.Power on and off: turn on and hold down the power button until the screen lights up. Turn off, press and hold the power button until the shutdown screen appears.
- 2.Volume Adjustment: under the standby interface, press "Side key one" / "Side key two" for adjustment.
- 3.Group selection: short press function (OK) key, see "Group function" menu, once again short press function "OK" key, select group after entering, short press function "OK" key, you can enter the group selection.
- 4.Single call function: short press the shortcut key to enter the member selection, select the required member down, press OK. The member name can be checked after the single call, stop the call after 30 seconds automatically exit single call.
- 5.System settings: short press function keys, up or down to select "Settings", enter after the selection of changes required to the next level of sub-table changes. To return to the previous menu, press "Return Key" to exit.
- 6.Keyboard Lock:you can lock/unlock after 3 seconds of long press on the shortcut key.

5. Trouble shooting

If your walkie-talkie in the use of the following phenomenon, please check the following information, if not ruled out, please contact us.

- 1.Unable to connect to the network
 - When the network environment is good, the internal components may be damaged or the SIM card is used up, please contact us.
- 2.Prompt to insert SIM card
 - SIM card may be in poor contact, can use alcohol wipe SIM card hardware and card slot hardware.
- 3.Unable to charge/power on
 - The charger may be damaged, try to replace the charger.
 - the battery may be damaged. Check the battery with a multimeter or replace the new battery.
- 4.If neither of the above is true, it is a problem with the charging interface of the machine or a damaged internal component.

6. Cleaning and maintenance

In order to ensure the product to play its good performance, and extend the service life, please be familiar with the following content, in order to better daily maintenance of this product clean.

- Do not puncture or scratch this product with a hard object.
- Do not store in an environment containing corrosive electronic circuits.
- Do not use the earphone cord when carrying or using.
- When not using the attachment, please cover the attachment interface silicone cover.

 Please shut down and take out the battery before cleaning.

- Use a clean, dry flannelette or brush regularly to remove dirt from surfaces and electrodes.
- When Keys, case dirty, can be used neutral detergent or alcohol for cleaning, in order to avoid the surface of the case damaged.
- After cleaning, be sure to dry thoroughly, otherwise do not use.
