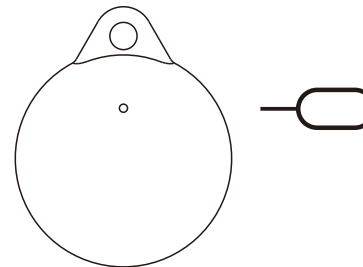


# Hello Tag

One device can connect 32 Hello Tag

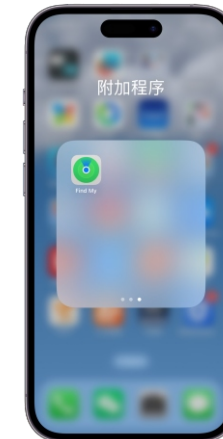


Power on: Push the button or insert the card needle into the keyhole, press boot.

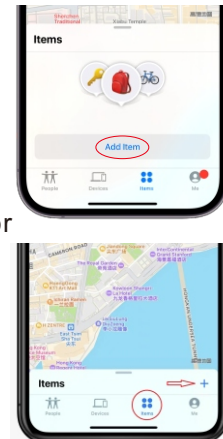
Power off: press the key or insert the card pin into the key hole, press the power off for a long time.

Restore factory Settings:

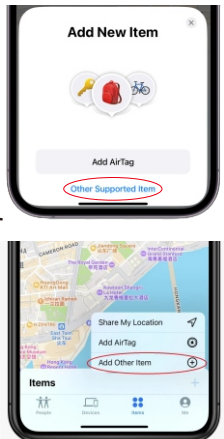
If you cannot find the product in the startup state, you need to restore factory Settings. Press the button 5 times in a row, the 5th time is 5 seconds long.



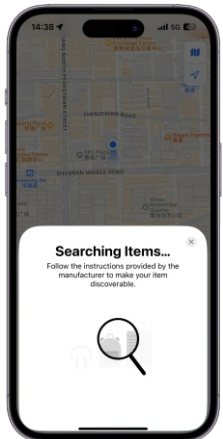
1. Connect the device: After turning on the device, use the "Find My" APP of the Apple device



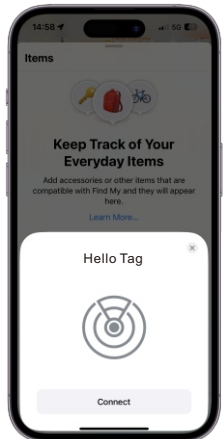
2. Click "Add Item"



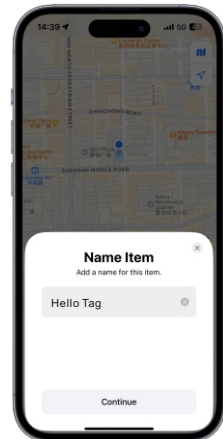
3. Click "Other Supported Item"



4. Enter the search state



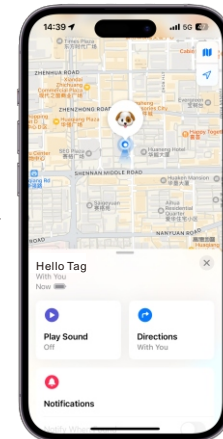
5. Find the product and click the "Connect"
