




Power on/off

Power on - Press and hold the button for 3 seconds until  LED lights flash and a beep is heard.

Power off - Press button repeatedly until the card displays , press and hold for 3 seconds until  flash, release then press and hold the button again for 3 seconds.

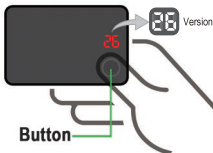

Make sure your phone can access to the Internet and grant the necessary permissions as shown in the image below.

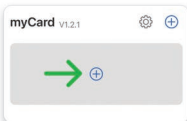

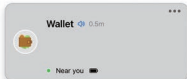

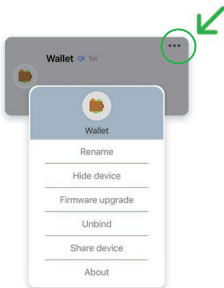

Menu Function List



Rename - Modify the name of a card.

Hide device - The card will not appear in the main interface, find it in the settings menu.

Firmware upgrade - Update the firmware via Bluetooth.

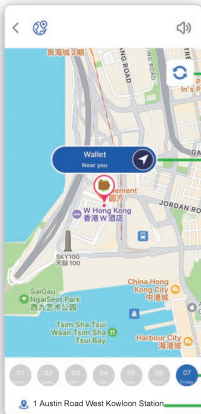
Unbind - Clear card data and reset.

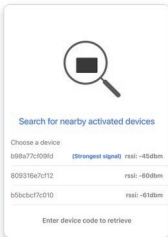
Ways to add a card

Click the "+" symbol to add a card in the top right corner of the main interface.

After getting a share code, tap "🔄" and enter the code to add the card.



🔍 Restore activated cards after reinstalling the app or switching to a new phone.



FAQ

1. App Installation Issues

Some phone protection modes (Huawei Pure Mode, Xiaomi Security Mode) may block the installation process. Please disable these modes and try again.

2. Failed to Add Card

Ensure Bluetooth is enabled and the card is powered on. If activation fails, check your network connection.

3. No Location Data

Check if the card is powered on. If it is, try moving to a more crowded area for better signal detection.

4. Retrieve Card After Changing Phones

Use the "+" Bluetooth recovery feature in the app to retrieve your card.

5. Location Offset

The device uses a crowdsourced network, not GPS. Location offsets may occur due to indoor environments or high-speed movement. Please check historical location data for more accurate results.

6. No Response in Nearby Search

Ensure Bluetooth permissions are enabled and the device is powered on. A gray beeping icon indicates the device is out of range. If the battery is low, only location tracking may be available, playing sound will not work.
