




How to set up the data adapter card?




1 Open the lock catch of the data adapter card.



2 Insert the data adapter card into the BYTE main unit.




3 After pushing the data adapter card in, tightly lock the catch.




4 With the installation completed, the fan starts to rotate.

Download the Goldshell Zone App or login to Goldshell Hub, then manually connect your BYTE to the app for control.

Note: The BYTE cannot be added through automatic search. Please choose to connect manually.
