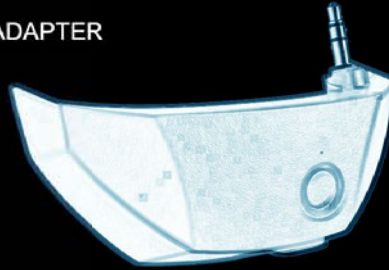


MODEL:W1 BT ADAPTER

1 DIAGRAM

Push the plug side harder.

2.After turn on, searching for "W1 adapter"click for connecting.

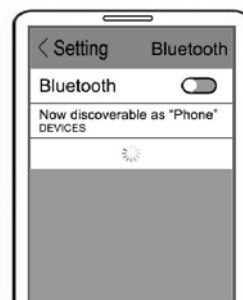


3.The adapter will flash blue light when working. if it flash red light. it means the battery is low.you will also hear "battery low" while using it.
