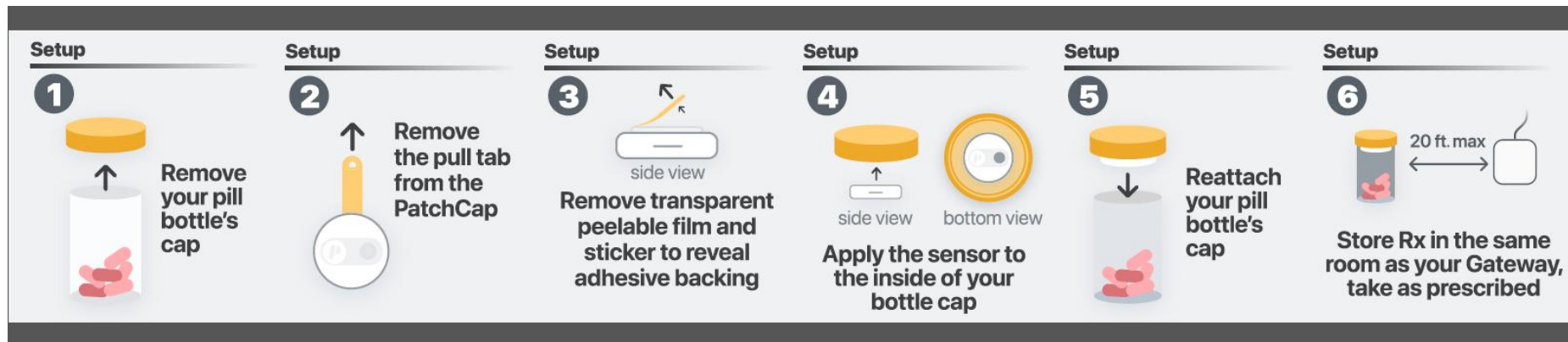

Follow the included steps to properly setup your PatchCap.
