User Manual

Precautions

Thank you for purchasing our walkie talkies.

The following precautions should be taken when using product:

- ◆ Make sure the channel is correct every time you turn on the walkie talkie. To avoid unnecessary errors, please make sure all the walkie talkie remain on the same channel.
- ◆ Keep the walkie talkie upright and ensure its microphone is 2-3 inches away from your mouth when you're talking.
- ◆ Keep the device away from high temperature, dampness, flammable gas or gas station during use.
- ◆ Do not charge the battery in a flammable or explosive environment.
- ◆ Do not use the device near the radio to avoid interference.
- ◆ Please hold the device by the main body instead of antenna to avoid possible damages and impact on conversation.
- ◆ Don't frequently turn on and off the device during use. Adjust the volume to a proper level.
- ◆ To prevent any problem caused by electromagnetic interference or electromagnetic compatibility, please turn off the device on the areas that are marked with off the walkie talkie, e.g. airport, gas station or other occasion.
- ◆ To avoid the risk of burns, do not use the device if the antenna is damaged in any way.
- ◆ If the device didn't give you response after pressing a specific button, its keypad maybe locked, to unlock the keypad, just press and hold the Menu/Lock button for 3 seconds until the symbol disappears.
- ◆ This product contains small parts(such as belt clips) that may cause suffocation if swallowed by children.
- ◆ Consult your doctor before use if you are carrying any kind of personal medical device.
- ◆ Please do not disassemble or assemble it by yourself.

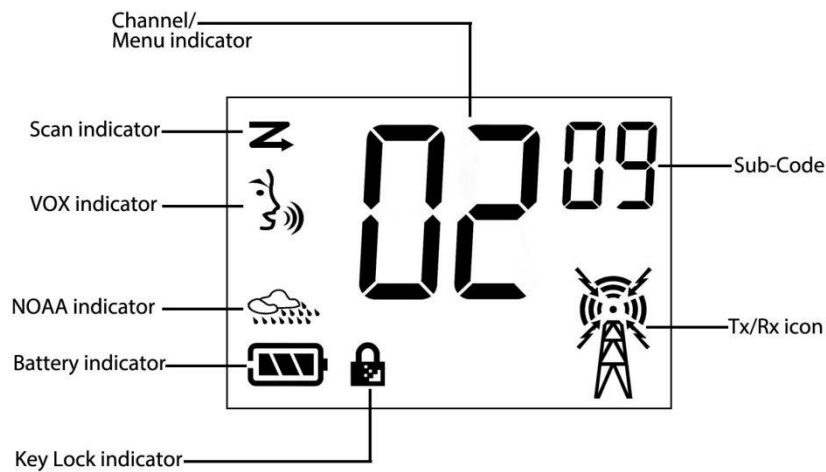

Belt Clip





1. Pry the elastic buckle



2. Push the belt clip upward

How to Charger

1. Please charge it before using it for the first time, please use a 5V 1A/2A charger.
2. There is a battery indication on the LCD screen. When the full capacity symbol  turns into empty capacity , indicating that it needs to be charged.
3. Please charge in time. When the battery icon flashes, it means that the battery is low. When full charged, the battery icon will stop.
4. To make the battery last longer, when walkie talkies is not in use, please turn off the device.




How to Use




1. Power On / Off

Power On: Rotate left the power/volume button until hear a “click” sound

Power Off: Rotate right the power/volume button until hear a “click” sound

2. Channel Settings:

Channel: Short press  one time, the channel starts to flash, press   to set the channel, there are 22 channels for you to set, after selected, press PTT to confirm.

Sub-Code: Short press  2 times, the sub-code start to flash, press   to set the sub-code, you can set 01-99, OF means no code, press PTT to confirm.



NOTE:

- To guarantee normal performance, make sure both the main channels and sub-codes of all walkie talkies are the same.
- You must set the sub-code to OF in order to communicate with other FRS radio stations that DO NOT have the sub-code.

3. How to Talk?





Pressing the PTT button, hold the walkie talkies 2-3 inches away from your mouth and speak directly into microphone. Don't cover the micro-phone when you're talking, and when you're finished, release the PTT.

4. Adjust the Volume (Please set a more reasonable volume level based on your current surroundings.)

Volume up: Rotate left the power/volume button after power on.

Volume down: Rotate right the power/volume button after power on.

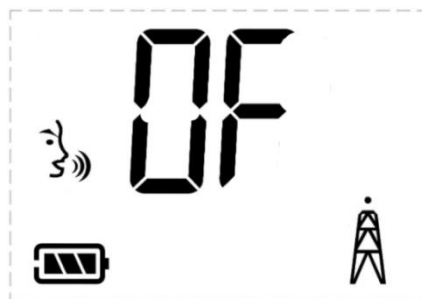
5. VOX (voice-operated exchange), you can talk into a walkie talkie microphone instead of pressing the PTT button.


Set VOX: Short press  3 times to enter VOX setting , default is OF(off), press   to set the sensitivity level and save the setting by pressing PTT button.


3 = high sensitivity (fits for quiet occasion)

2 = medium sensitivity (fits for most occasions)







1 = low sensitivity (fits for noisy occasions)

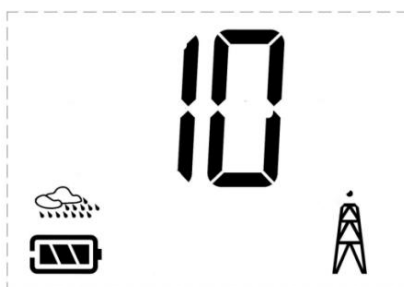


6. Call: Short press  to call your group members.



7. Flashlight: Short press  to turn on or off the flashlight.

8. NOAA Setting:

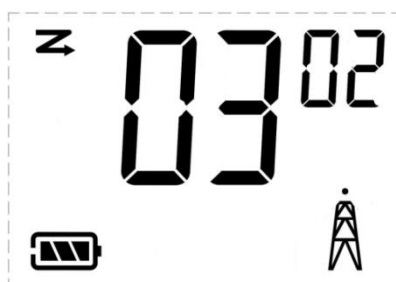
Long press and hold  for 3 seconds to enter the NOAA menu , it will scan 11 NOAA radio channels automatically. If you want to select NOAA channel manually, short press menus button  to stop scan, then press   to set your desired NOAA channel. Long press and hold  for 3 seconds to exit NOAA menu.




9. Channel Scan:

Long press and hold  for 3 seconds to scan channel automatically, also long press and hold  for 3 seconds to exit channel scan menu.



When the device detects an available channel signal, it will automatically stop scanning and you will be able to hear the transmitted voice simultaneously. To enter this channel and respond the transmission, please press the PTT button within 5 seconds, otherwise the channel will scan again.







10. Lock the Keypad (Channel-lock) :

Long press and hold  for 3 seconds to lock or unlock the keypad (Channel-lock) . In the keypad locking state, Channel settings, Channel scan and NOAA is unavailable, you can still turn on /off the walkie talkie, press PTT to talk or receive signal, send a call and turn on/off flashlight.






11. Alert Setting: Long press and hold  button for 3 seconds to start-up alert, the flashlight will keep flashing and you will hear alert sound. If you want to stop alert, please also long press and hold  button for 3 seconds.

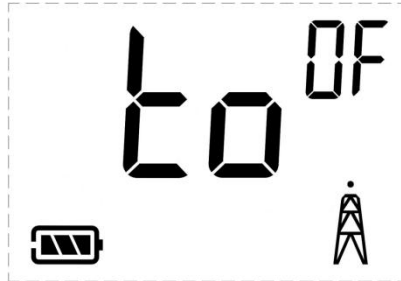
12. Call Tone Setting:

Short press  4 times, screen will display  and "01" start to flash, press   to select the call tone(total 10 calling tone), press PTT to confirm.






13. Key Tone Setting:

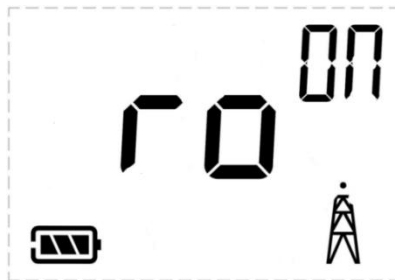
Short press  5 times, screen will display **LO^{OF}**, and “ON” start to flash, press   to turn on or off the button sound, press PTT to confirm.




14. End Call Tone Setting:

Short press  6 times, screen will display **EO^{ON}**, and “ON” start to flash, press   to turn on or off the end call tone, press PTT to confirm.

“ON” means there will be a tone when PTT is released, “OF” means there will be no tone.



15. Factory Reset:

Please turn off the walkie talkie, then press & hold  button, turn on walkie talkie again at the same time.
