

3.0 Key function guide

**X1:** Press once   **Hold:** Press and hold

	X 1		<b>Activate the Siri mode</b> Short press to wake up the Siri assistant
	Hold	<b>ANC</b>	<b>Noise canceling mode</b> Long press 2S to switch the headphones to active noise-canceling mode
	Turn	<b>EQ</b>	<b>Switch music modes</b> 5 Coolest Music Modes (Rock/Pop/Electronic/Jazz/Classical)
	X 1		<b>Previous song</b> Short press to switch to the previous song
	Hold		<b>Volume up</b> Long press 2S to increase the volume
	Hold		<b>On/Off button</b> Press and hold the power button 3S to turn on, press and hold the power button 3S to turn off
	X 1		<b>Play/Pause</b> In music mode: Short press to switch between play/pause
	X 1		<b>Answer/Hang up</b> Short press on/off button to answer/hang up call
	Hold		<b>Reject</b> In phone mode: Long press 2S to reject the call

## 5.0 Bluetooth pairing

### Steps:

Turn on the headphones and enable Bluetooth on your mobile phone. Search for the "Y02 ANC" and connect to the headphones.



## 6.0 Charging

When the headphones are either powered on or powered off, plug in a Type-C charging cable, and the headphone power light will stay red while charging and turn off after fully charged.

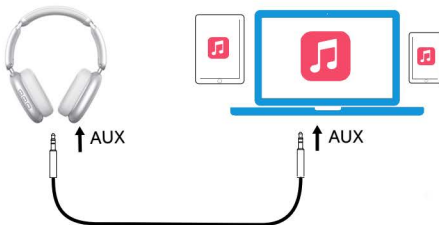
(Note: Plugging in the charging cable while the headphones are powered on will result in the headphones automatically turning off.)

## 7.0 Aux audio cable

1. When the headphones are powered off, insert a 3.5mm AUX audio cable to play music from a phone or other player to experience Hi-Res sound quality.

2. When the headphones are powered on, inserting a 3.5mm AUX audio cable will automatically turn off the headphones.

(Note: Using this function while the headphones are charging is not recommended.)
