1A Download the Tuya app by scanning the QR code above.

1B install the app. Making an account is optional but grants you more features.

1C installing the camera only take a few minutes, Additionally the app itself will guide you through most of the steps.

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2.1 Add Device

2A Top the '+' icon in the top right corner to add a device.

2B scroll down and select "Camera & lock" from the options on the left

2C Select 'smart Camera (2.4 GHz & 5 GHz)' from the available options.

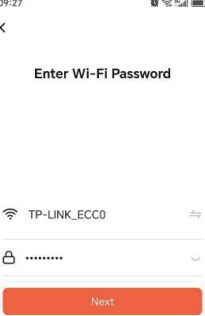
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2.2 Connect with WiFi

3A Ensure the camera is powered on and ready to be connected.

3B Make sure the blue light is blinking and red light is on,When you hear the a beep, indicating that the camera is ready.

3C Connect the camera to your Wi-Fi network.



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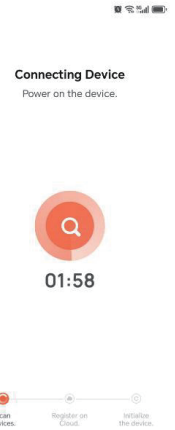
2.3 Establish Connection

4A The app will show a QR code. Scan The code by pointing the camera's lens towards the code, Keep a distance of 15-20 cm

4B Wait for the message connection start.

4C The device will start establishing a connection, which may take up to 2 minutes.

4D Ensure you are close to your Wi-Fi signal To expedite the process.Once connected, The blue indicator of the device will remain steady on



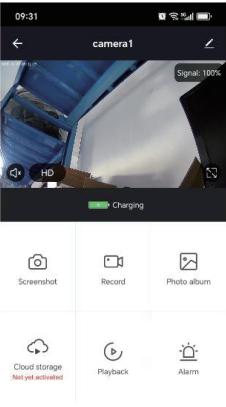
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2.4 Final Steps

5A Give the camera a name based on its location.

5B You will be directed to the camera's live view.

5C In the bottom right corner, you can activate the alarm and adjust its sensitivity to your preferences.



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3. Reset Instructions

1A If you have issues connecting the camera hold the 'Reset' button of the device for about 4 seconds, This will reset the connection and allow you to set it up again.

1B If the reset is successful, the camera's blue light will go off

1C Follow the setup guide instructions from the start.

4. Restart

1A Every time you restart the camera it will have to establish a connection with your WiFi. Usually this takes less than 30 sec, but it is dependent on your signal strength.

1B After the blue indicator is off, wait about 40S until the blue indicator blinks again. Reconfigure the WIFI network

1C If this process takes long try to move to a location with a better connection strength to expedite the process

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5. Charging

1A The package includes a 5V 1A (5W) charger Please ensure that you exclusively utilize this charger or one with similar specifications for charging the device, Employing a more powerful charger, often referred to as fast chargers,could potentially damage the device.

2A To charge the device, insert the Type c cable into the charging port and connect the adapter to a power outlet,You can also utilize power banks for charging,but ensure that their output is limited to 5V 1A (5W).
