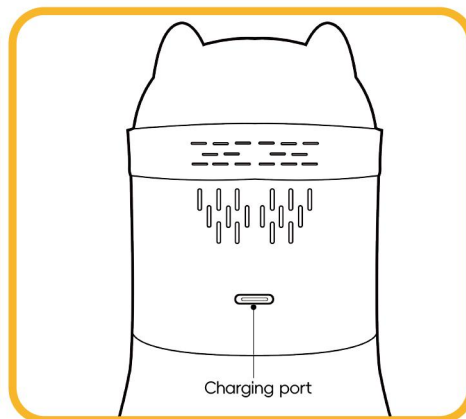
INSTALLATION STEPS



BUTTON DESCRIPTION



- ① Previous
- ② Short press to power on/long press to power off/return to home
- ③ Next
- ④ Previous Atlas
- ⑤ Auto-play/long press switch sound
- ⑥ Next Atlas



*Please use a charging plug with a voltage of 5V and a current of $\leq 1.2A$ to charge.

INSTRUCTIONS

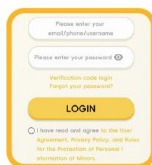
1. Plug it in and turn it on, and you can use the drawing function

- (1) Built-in 50 sets of high-precision painting atlases.
- (2) The companion app provides a continuous update service of the cloud gallery, and can download more than 100 kinds of paintings series and sync to the device.
- (3) The device supports a maximum of 100 sets of atlas storage locally, when the new atlas exceeds the capacity limit, the system will automatically cycle through the override according to the principle of "old atlas first replace" to ensure that the system ensures that the old atlas is replaced first. Users always use the most up-to-date resources.



2. To use the full functionality, download the app

- (1) Apple users search for "curious alpacas" in the App Store to download and install it;
- (2) Android users scan the QR code on the right to download and install;
- (3) Connect the device.
