#### **Mobile Phone Connection:**

- 1. After removing the earbuds, turn on Bluetooth on your phone and search for devices. The pairing name will appear as: (SJQ-1).
- 2. Click to connect. (When removed, the earbuds' blue light flashes. After mutual connection between earbuds, a single earbud's blue light flashes. The light turns off once connected to the phone, with a voice prompt: "Connected").

## **Touch Controls:**

- 1. Volume Control: Single-click the left earbud to increase volume, right earbud to decrease.
- 2. Play/Pause: Double-click the left or right earbud.
- 3. Previous/Next Track: Triple-click the left earbud for previous track, right earbud for next track.
- 4. Chinese/English Language Switch: Quadruple-click to toggle languages.
- 5. Voice Assistant: Press and hold for 3 seconds during standby or playback to activate.

## **Bluetooth Call Functions:**

- 1. Single-click to answer/end a call.
- Press and hold for 3 seconds to reject a call.

#### **Additional Features:**

#### **Earbuds:**

- 1. Single earbud can be used independently.
- 2. The phone can display the power level of the earbuds.
- 3. Power on/off prompts with voice notifications.
- 4. Low battery alerts with voice prompts.

## **Charging Case:**
