

3.2 Wear

Personal Sound Amplifier L/R Recognition

3.3 Power on/off

Open the charging box and take out the Personal Sound Amplifier, it will automatically turn on, or long press the button for 5s to turn on.

Power off: put the Personal Sound Amplifier into the charging box, close the charging box cover, the Personal Sound Amplifier will automatically shut down, or long press the button for 5s to shutdown the Personal Sound Amplifier.

3.4 Volume adjustment

Short press the button each time, the volume increases one level, if the volume is at maximum volume, press the button again, the volume would be turned to minimum volume.

3.5 Pairing

(1) When you first open the charging case (if the Personal Sound Amplifier has not been paired before), the Personal Sound Amplifier will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode.

If the Personal Sound Amplifier has already been paired with a device and the device is nearby, you will see the Personal Sound Amplifier to automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode.

(2) Open the phone, click the "Settings" icon, and then select "Bluetooth".

3.6 Touch key description

(1) Audio mode switch (indoor/outdoor/concert hall): triple-click




(2) Pause/Play music: Double click




