

User Manual

Personal Precautions While Using

To prevent accidents, please adhere to the following guideline. Carefully read the manual and use this product safely.

- Always use manufacturer-approved installation components, accessories, and replacement parts.
- Do not open the casing of the product without authorization. Unauthorized modifications void the warranty.
- Avoid subjecting the product to strong impacts or pressure.
- Use the product only under the operating conditions specified in the technical data.
- Keep liquids and conductive objects away from the product and its connection ports.
- When unplugging the charger, hold the plug instead of pulling on the charging cable.
- This product may interfere with hearing aids, pacemakers, other medical devices, fire alarms, automatic doors, and other automated control systems. Avoid using this product near such equipment to prevent malfunctions or accidents.

- Do not disassemble, open, or crush secondary cells or batteries.


- To protect your hearing, do not use this product at high volumes for extended periods.



Charging Instructions


※ Before the first use, please fully charge the product using the included Type-C cable.

※ Batteries are consumables. Even with proper charging and discharging methods, their usable time will gradually decrease. Charging and playback timemay vary depending on the operating environment.

Charging the Earphones


※ Place the earphones into the charging case and close the lid.

※ Ensure the earphones are correctly placed in the charging case. If the left and right earphones are placed incorrectly, the charging contacts on the earphones will not connect to the charging pins in the case, resulting in the earphones not charging.



Charging the Earphone Case

- Connect the Type-C cable to the charging case's Type-C port.
- Plug the charging cable into a USB port on your computer, or use a commercially available USB-compatible power adapter and connect it to a power outlet.




Charging Earphone Case

※ Low Battery Alert

When the earphone battery level drops below 20%, you will hear a voice prompt saying "Battery Is Low. Please Charge." We recommend charging immediately. When the charging case battery level falls below 10%, the LCD screen will display a red battery indicator icon.

Personal Precautions While Using

Rotate the earphone body and insert it into your ear.



※ The device includes three sizes of ear tips (S, M, and L). Please use the most suitable size. (M-size ear tips come pre-installed).

※ Do not place the earphone directly on the touch button. When wearing the device at night, the touch function may be accidentally activated due to movement.

Instruction Manual

Power on

Method 1: When the earbuds are removed from the charging case, you will hear the voice prompt "Power on", and they will automatically power on for Bluetooth pairing.

Method 2: Press and hold the touch button (when disconnected) to manually turn on the earbuds. The Bluetooth icon (top-left corner of the charging case's LCD screen) will display a white symbol with an overlapping [X].

Power off

Method 1: Place both earbuds into the charging case and close the lid to automatically power them off.

Method 2: Press and hold the touch button (when powered on but disconnected) to manually turn them off. After both earbuds shut down, the Bluetooth icon (top-left corner of the LCD screen) will turn red.

Pairing

- Power on the earbuds, then go to the Bluetooth settings on your device → "Bluetooth" - select "T27" from the device list.
- Once connected, you will hear the English prompt "Connected," and the Bluetooth icon in the top-left corner of the charging case's LCD screen will change to a white Bluetooth icon.

Reset

① If the connection is not working or you want to return to the initial state, follow the reset steps: When the left/right earbud is not paired, press the touch button on the left/right earbud five times. You will hear the English prompt "[Power off]." then place the earbud back into the charging case.

② On your Bluetooth device's Bluetooth settings screen, select "T27" and disconnect, then restart the compatible device.

③ The earbuds will automatically re-pair with the compatible device.



Charging Case Multifunctional Operations

LCD Touch Screen Operation

The Bluetooth icon is displayed in the top-left corner of the LCD screen.


Music Playback Control

Tap to play/pause or skip forward/backward through songs.



Volume Control

Adjust the volume following the on-screen instructions to decrease or increase the sound.




ANC Mode Settings

(Normal Mode / ANC Mode / Transparency Mode)


You can select the optimal noise cancellation mode based on your usage.

- ① Normal mode: The default mode
- ② ANC Mode: Cancels noise for better focus.
- ③ Transparency Mode: Hear surroundings without removing earbuds.




Equalizer Settings

The equalizer offers five modes: Normal, Rock, Pop, Classical, and Jazz. You can switch between these modes to find your preferred sound.




Alarm Settings

Set alarms as needed. (5min / 10min / 30min / 60min)




Brightness Settings

Adjust the brightness as instructed on the screen to make it clearly visible.




Language Settings

Switch between languages of your choice.



Wallpaper Settings

You can set the wallpaper to an image of your choice.



Find Earbuds Function

Tap the "L Earbud/R Earbud" icon, then follow the on-screen instructions to locate each earbud.

※ The earbuds must be powered on.

※ The earbuds must be within Bluetooth connection range.



Time and Date

In addition to confirming the time and date, you can also set time calibration.



Camera Function

Press the camera icon to remotely trigger the shutter button on connected devices such as smartphones.

※ To use this feature, grant permission through your smartphone during the initial pairing.



Lighting Function

After pressing the flashlight icon, the touch screen will emit a white light.



Frequently Asked Questions

No Power

- If the battery is low, place the earbuds in the charging case to recharge.
- Dirty charging contacts (the metal parts) may affect charging. Clean them gently with a soft, dry cloth.

No Sound

- Disconnect the earbuds from your smartphone or other audio devices, then attempt pairing them again. Restart your phone or computer if needed.
- Wireless interference could be causing the issue. Try moving the earbuds closer to the audio source.
- Stay away from phones, microwaves, or Wi-Fi routers, as they may cause interference.
- Nearby Bluetooth devices may also cause interference. Turn off Bluetooth or power off other devices to resolve the issue.

Unable to Pair with Bluetooth Device

- If the device is already connected to another device, turn off Bluetooth or power off the unused device.
- Ensure Bluetooth is turned off on the device you want to connect to.
- Check if the device's operating system is outdated and update it to the latest version.
- Remove the existing pairing settings and start the pairing process from scratch
- Check if the earbuds are out of battery.
