



<h2>User Manual</h2> <p>Wireless Adapter for CarPlay &amp; Android Auto</p> <p>— Wireless 2-in-1 Adapter —</p>	<h3>Critical Setup Notes</h3> <p>1. Please Remove original car Bluetooth from your phone's paired devices list to prevent connection conflicts.</p> <p>2. Keep phone WiFi on without manual connection, the adapter will auto-connect after Bluetooth pairing (WiFi manual connection is used for OTA updates)</p> <p>3. Please Pair Bluetooth ONLY between phone &amp; the adapter (do NOT connect the adapter to car Bluetooth).</p>	<h3>Compatibility Notes</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please ensure that your car is compatible with wired CarPlay or Android Auto.</li> <li>• The wireless CarPlay feature requires an iPhone 6 or a newer model with iOS 10 or higher.</li> <li>• The wireless Android Auto feature requires an Android phone with version 11 or higher that supports the latest Android Auto features.</li> </ul>	<p><b>How to check your vehicle supports wired CarPlay or wired Android Auto</b></p> <p>● <b>Method 1:</b> Connect your iPhone or Android smartphone to the vehicle using a USB data cable. The connection interface logo will then appear on the car's display screen.</p> <p>● <b>Method 2:</b> Refer to the compatibility list by Scanning the QR code or go to the website. Start the car and wait for the system to be loaded.</li> <li>2. Insert the adapter into the vehicle's USB -A or USB-C port.</li> <li>3. Once the adapter is successfully connected to the vehicle, the screen will display the adapter's Bluetooth name as "smartBox-xxxx".</li> <li>4. Open the Settings on your iPhone and enable "Bluetooth" and "WLAN".</li> <li>5. Go to the "Bluetooth" settings and select the adapter with the name "smartBox-xxxx" from the Available devices list.</li> </ol>	<p>6. A "Bluetooth Pairing Request" notification will appear on your phone screen. Click "Pair" to proceed.</p> <p>7. Wait for about 20-30 seconds. A dialog box will appear on the phone screen asking "Use CarPlay with 'smartBox-xxxx'" Click "Use CarPlay" to establish a connection between your phone and the adapter.</p> <p>8. After Bluetooth pairing is complete and the CarPlay connection is established, the car screen will automatically switch to CarPlay mode.</p> <p>9. If the mobile phone system prompts that Bluetooth is occupied, please try pairing several times to complete the device handover.</p>

Then connect the Available devices (smartBox-XXXX)</li> <li>5.
