### CHARGING YOUR DEVICE

For rst time use, charge the battery until it is full.

Use the included wall charger.

The Tablet PC screen shows that your device is charging and displays the power level.

### Startup and Shutdown

#### Startup

Press and hold the power button to turn the tablet on. The first boot will enter the boot mode, and the first boot into the system will be very slow. Select the appropriate language for the first boot. Select the connected WiFi, enter the password to connect, or choose to set it offline.

The date and time can be adjusted as needed, after the adjustment is completed, click Next.

Read more about google services and click for more. After reading all the service details, click Accept to enter the screen setting password, or skip. Wait for the tablet to load and use it.

#### Shutdown

Long press POWER, it will populous shutdown window. Shutdown window contains mute mode, airplane mode, rebootmode and shutdown four options. Click Shutdown is the last step.

### Open and Close of the Screen

**Screen will be closed on its own when no operation happens.**

Screen will be closed on its own if no operation happens forsome time to save battery powerWhen screen is open, press POWER key, the screen will be closed immediately.

**Turn it on when you close the screen.**

If the screen is off, tap POWER to turn it on. The screen will display the lock status, swipe the unlock icon up to "Unlock screen"

### USB Connection

#### Table storage configuration

Before transmitting documents,you have to conduct storageconfiguration for your Table

- 1.Connect the Table and computer by USB cable, the remindercolumn will show the remind information.
- 2.Open the reminder board; please view the Table status andreminder to learn how to open the board.
3. In the reminder board, click the "USB Connected", then click "open USB storage configuration"
4. Now the USB is connected successfully.

#### Copy the document into memory card

1. Conneet the Table to computer with USB cable.
- 2.As Table storage configuration, it is connected with computer successfully.
- 3.Open the "My computer" in your computer, check the items

in""removable disc".

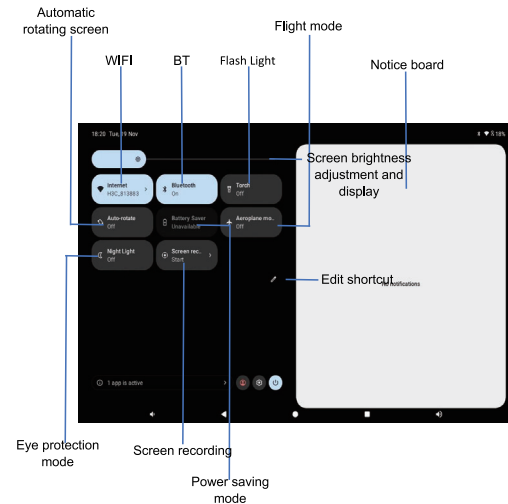
4. Copy the documents you need into "removable dise".

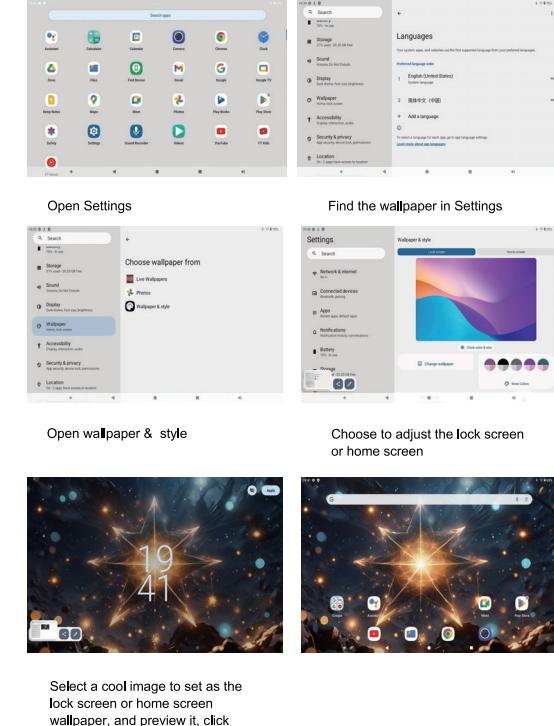
### Shortcut bar
