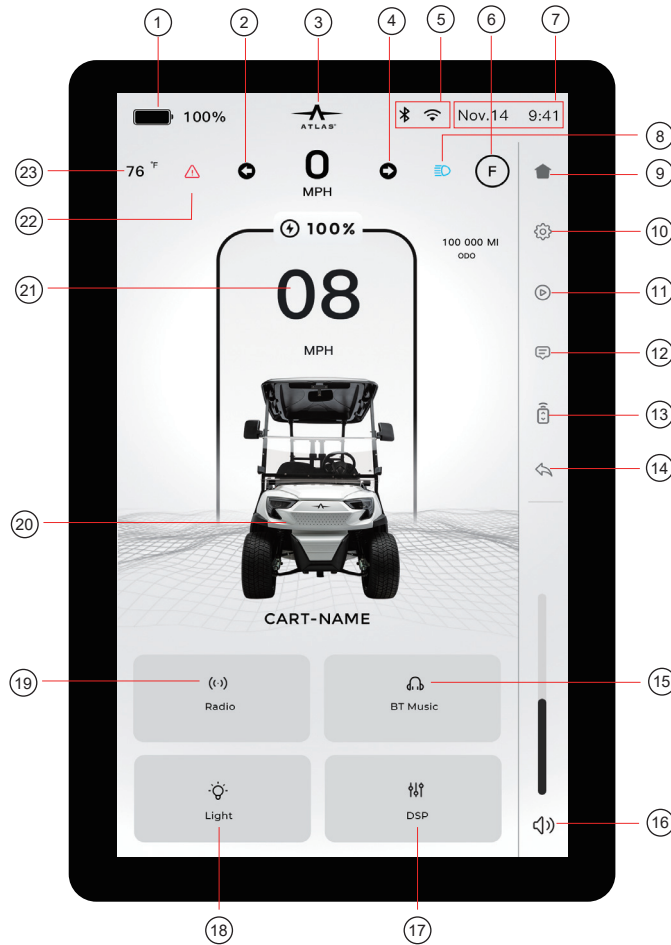

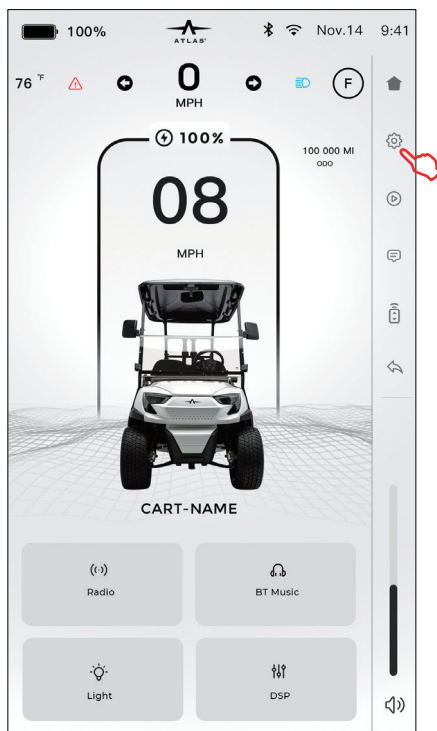

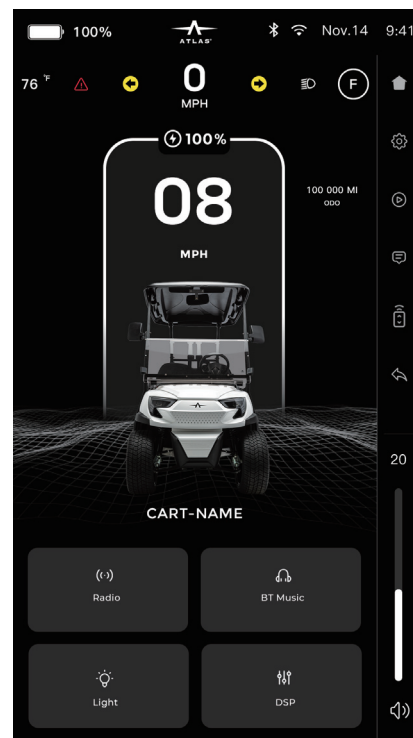
Application list

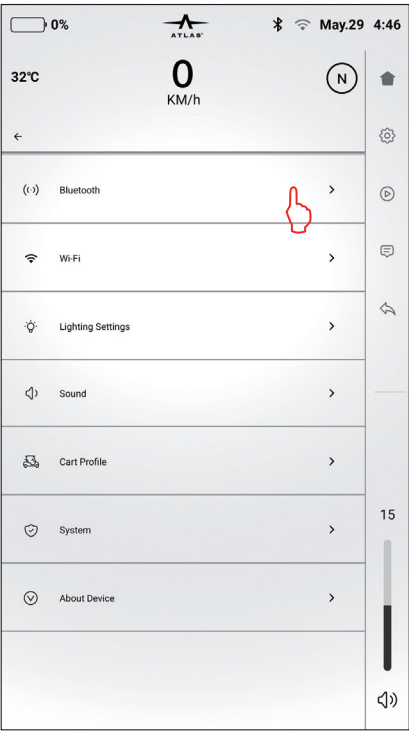
RDS will allow you to display information such as traffic status, radio station name and more

BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

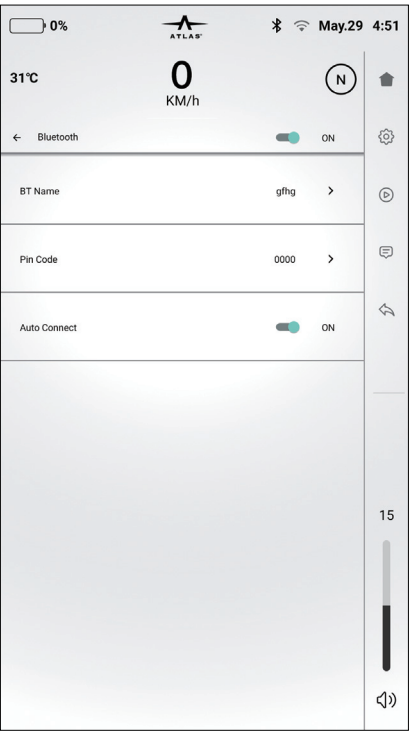
Bluetooth Interface

1. Turn on Bluetooth in Settings, otherwise you can't connect Bluetooth.
2. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your cell phone, then search for the device in your cell phone, find the device with the device name (Bluetooth name in the device)", and then tap the device name to complete the connection.
3. Open the automatic connection in the Bluetooth settings, and you can connect automatically after matching.

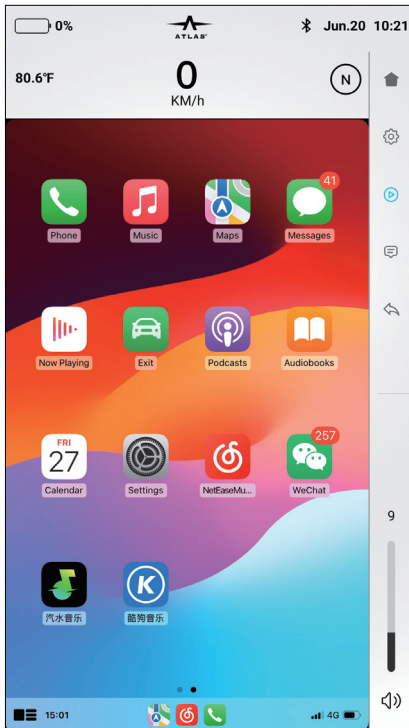

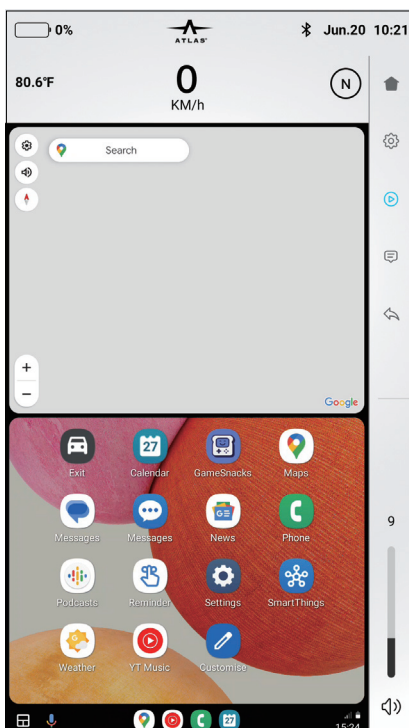
CARPLAY CONNECTION

Carplay and Android auto

1. Connect your iPhone to the machine via Bluetooth > select "Use Carplay" in the mobile pop-up message that appears > it will automatically connect to your iPhone.



2. Please download and install the Android Auto application to your Android phone (the phone must support Google services). "Connect to your phone via Bluetooth Connect for a few moments and the phone and machine will automatically connect.

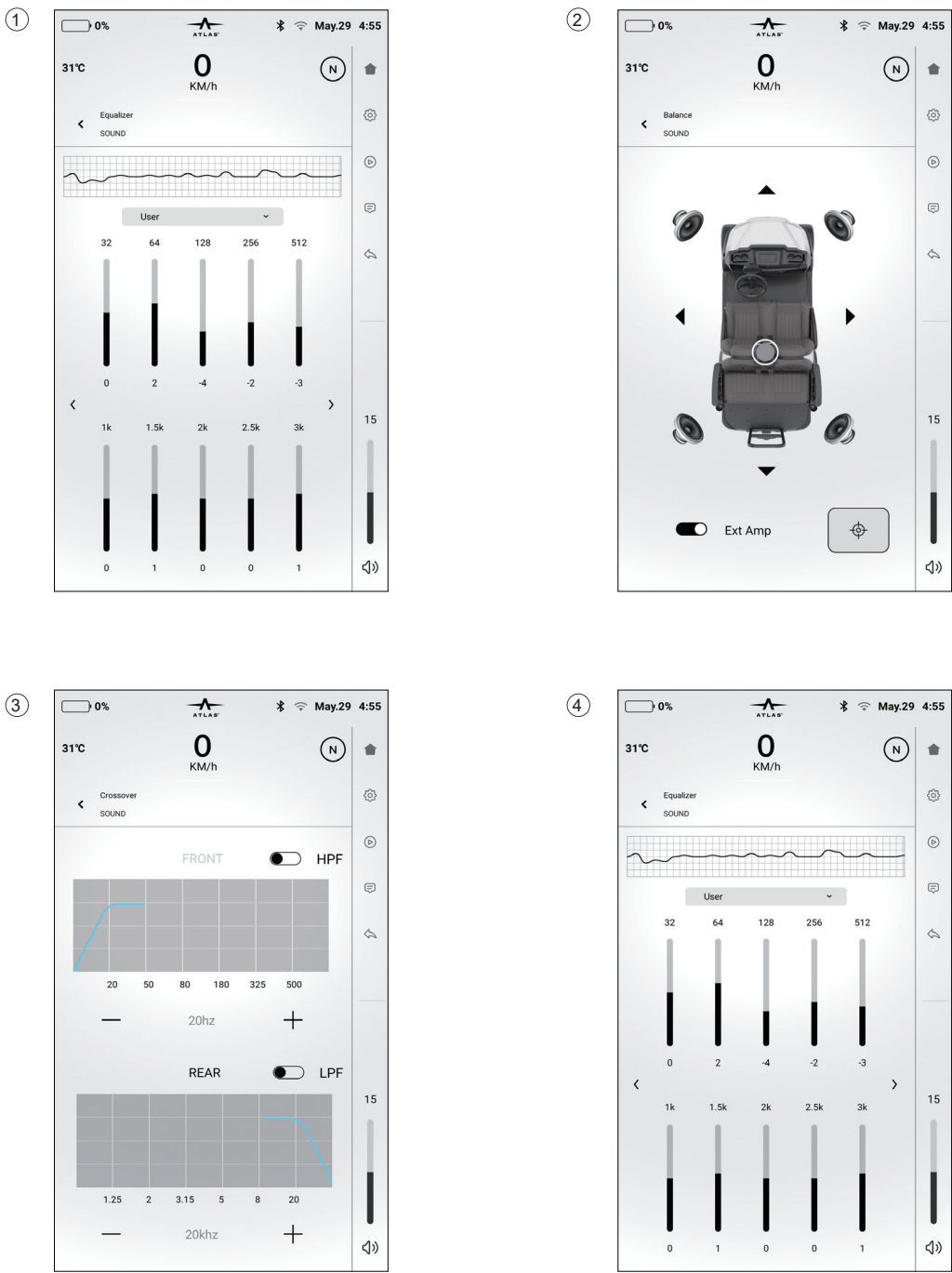
1. Manually adjust the black and white theme.

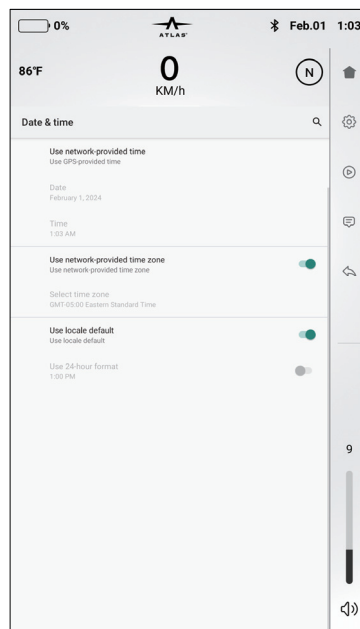
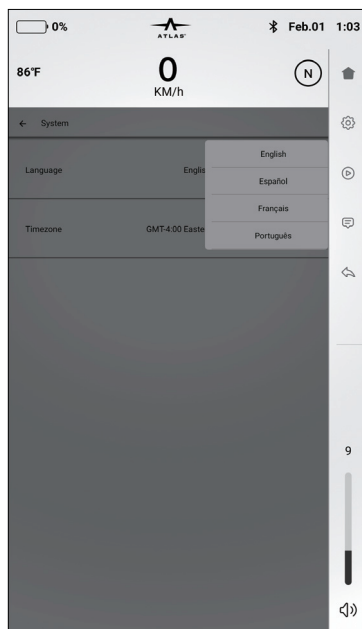
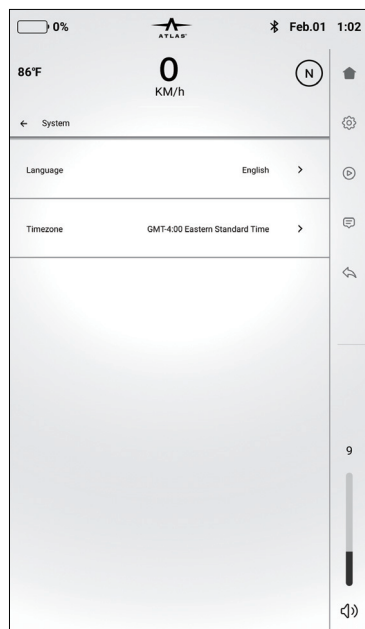
- 1.You can change the name of the cart.

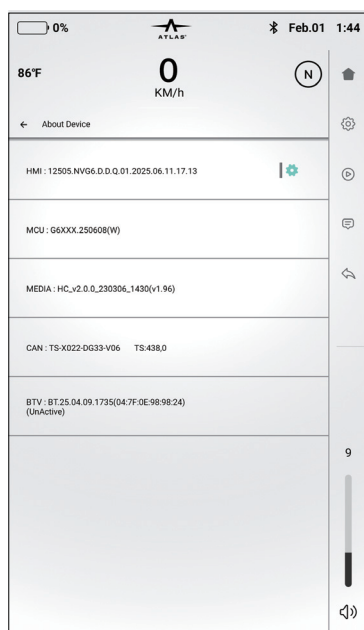
- 1.Click Settings for language settings (English, Spanish, Portuguese, French)

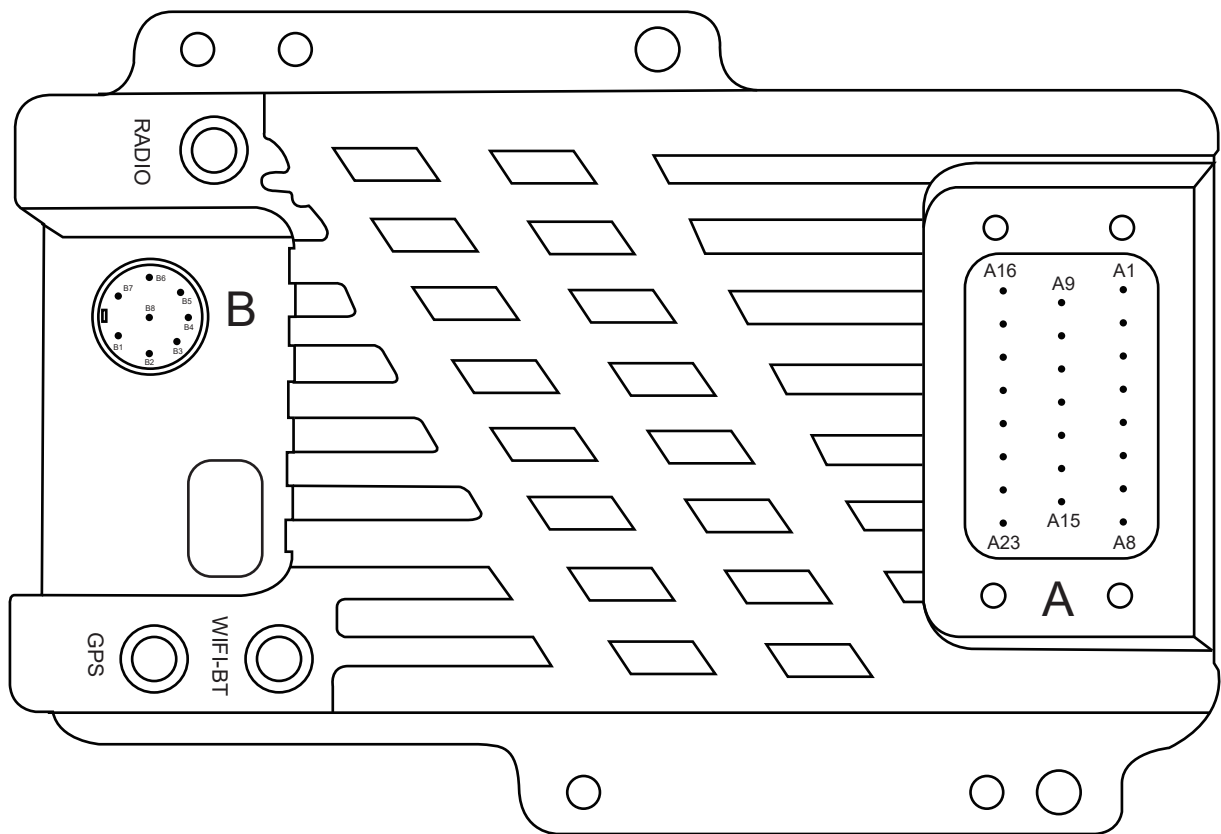
