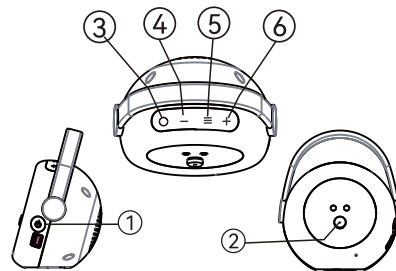

## Precautions

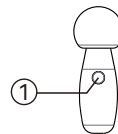
1. This product contains small parts. Children under 3 years old should use it under adult supervision.
2. The built-in 3.7V battery cannot be removed or replaced.
3. Please use a 5V $\Rightarrow$ 2A charger to charge this product (the charger should be used by an adult or under adult supervision).
4. Do not immerse the host in water or liquid;
5. Do not use this product in an environment with high temperature, high pressure, humidity, strong static electricity or magnetic field.
6. Before cleaning, the product should be disconnected from the charger and the surface stains should be wiped with a dry cloth. Do not disassemble the product by yourself to avoid danger.
7. The battery must not be exposed to sunlight, fire or similar overheating environments.
8. Avoid dropping the product from a height or subjecting it to excessive pressure.

### 1、Instructions

#### ① Power on/off

Long press the power button for 3 seconds, and the device will turn on after the power-on prompt tone is played; when the device is turned on, long press the power button for 3 seconds, and the shutdown prompt tone is played, and the device will turn off. The indicator light is red when charging, and the red light is off when fully charged, and the blue light is on when working.

#### ② Bluetooth connection

Press and hold the menu button for 3 seconds to enter Bluetooth mode. When your phone searches for "G2", click to connect. Press and hold the menu button again to switch back to music mode.

#### ③ Audio Playback

A: Long press the menu button to switch Bluetooth mode.

B: Short press the volume up/down button to play the previous/next song. Long press the volume button to adjust the volume.






C: Long press the play button to return to the first song in the current folder and play it.

D: Long press the colorful light switch to realize single song loop/continuous play function.

#### ④ Microphone function

Long press the microphone power button to turn the microphone on and off, and short press the switch to switch between original singing/backing singing mode.
