
Children's Emotional Intelligence Device – User Manual

1. Power Controls

Power On: Long press → Startup tone plays → Green light turns on → Resumes playback from last track

Power Off: Long press → Shutdown tone plays → Green light turns off

Pause/Resume:

Short press → Pauses playback (green light flashes) → Auto-shutdown after 30min inactivity

Short press again → Resumes playback (green light steady)

2. Volume & Track Controls

Volume Adjustment:

Long press "+" → Volume up (12 levels)

Long press "-" → Volume down (min: mute; default: medium)

Track Navigation:

Short press "+" → Next track (no continuous skip)

Short press "-" → Previous track (no continuous skip)

3. Bluetooth Mode

Activation: Long press Bluetooth button → Blue light flashes → Pair via device (name: **ES03**) → Connection tone plays → Blue light steady

Playback:

Volume/track controls affect device only (see Section 2).

Pause/resume via device button or connected Bluetooth device.

Exit: Long press Bluetooth button (5 sec) → Blue light off → Resumes pre-Bluetooth track.

Note: Expression changes disabled in Bluetooth mode.

4. Reading Mode (Short Press)

Cycles through tracks:

#31 (Sensory Enlightenment)

#32 (Magic Sound Castle)

#33 (Little Lines)

#34 (Rainbow City)

#50 (Children's Songs)

Memory playback resumes from last exited track.

5. Additional Functions

Expression Change: Rotate dial → Plays current folder track (cycles within folder).

Factory Reset: Long press "Volume +" + "Bluetooth" simultaneously.

System Recovery: Long press Reading button (5 sec).

6. Charging & Battery

Low Battery: Red light flashes + "Low battery" tone.

Charging:

Powered on: Green light off + "Charging started" tone.

Powered off: Red light on.

Playback disabled during charging; no auto-power-on when full.

7. Bluetooth Connection Steps

Long press Bluetooth button (blue light flashes).

On your device, search for **ES03** and connect.

Blue light stays steady when paired.

Play audio via connected device.
