



Before you start




Remove the protective film from your glasses.

Important: Follow the setup steps in the app before continuing.









Start captioning

Change language




Open the Captify app Select your preferred

language.



Installing prescription inserts








Step 1: Pull out the small plastic cover above the nose bridge.

Step 2: Align the pins on your prescription insert and press it into the holes until it clicks into place.


Adjusting the nosepads
