SPOT CLEAN

For light dirt, wipe with a damp cloth.

GENTLE WASH

For a deeper clean, hand wash with cool water and a drop of mild soap. Rinse thoroughly.

AIR DRY ONLY

Pat with a towel and lay flat to air dry completely before wearing.

Avoid direct heat or sunlight as it can cause fading and damage.

WIPE CLEAN

Regularly wipe the strap with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For tougher grime, you can use a soft-bristled brush to gently clean the mesh.

DRY IMMEDIATELY

If the strap gets wet, dry it thoroughly with a soft cloth. Prolonged exposure to water can cause fading and damage.
