
Buttons Function



1. Using Your Speaker

1. Turn ON/OFF

Press and hold the switch for 2s



⚠ The speaker will automatically turn off after 10 minutes if no device is connected.

2. Charger Your Speaker



	Flashing red	Low power
	Steady red	Charging
	OFF	Fully charged

⚠ Use the included USB cable to charge your speaker and make sure it is fully charged before first use.

3. Pair With Your Device

*Press and hold the power button 3s, Indicator will flashlight red and blue fast

*open the Bluetooth on your device and select "SP-005" start to pairing.



*When turned on, the speaker will automatically connect to the last connected device if available. If not, it will enter pairing mode

*Having connection problems? Remove "SP-005" from your device's Bluetooth history, ensure it's less than 3 feet away then try pairing again.

*TWS (True Wireless Stereo) Mode Two speakers can pair with each other for stereo sound. Both speakers can play the same audio (one as the left channel and the other as the right channel).
With one speaker connected to a smartphone, Press and hold into Tws mode



The device must ensure less than 3 feet
