




PlantBot

User Guide





Basic

- Long press the button 1 to power on/off.
- Press the button 2 to switch interface.
- Press the button 1 for three times to reconfigure.

Setup

1. Download the "Tuya Smart" app from the app store.
2. Power up PlantBot and follow instruction on-screen.
3. Up to 3 modes for your choice:

Mode 1 Seed: Prepare seed pack and follow instruction on-screen.

Mode 2 Cuttage: Prepare cuttings of plant and follow instruction on-screen.

Mode 3 Plant: Prepare 4 inch" Plant and follow instruction on-screen.

Tips

1. Support Wi-Fi 2.4GHz, do not use Wi-Fi 5GHz.
2. Please use garden soil provided by us or any professional shop for planting. Outdoor soil contains a lot of bacteria that will kill your plant, do not use.
3. Do not water the plants directly, pour the water into the water tank.




