When you use it for the first time, use a screwdriver to twist off the top battery cover screw, put in the 9V battery, and then cover the battery cover.</li><li>2. Press the center on button of the alarm, press the left button again the pool unit and home unit will be connected automatically. Press the left button of the alarm, the product will work normally only after 30 seconds, at this time, you can put the alarm into the pool and wait for the work.</li></ol></div> <div></div> <div>There are hanging holes on the back of the home unit, so you can hang it on top of a wall hook or nail to secure it. If there are no hooks on the wall, you can choose to fix it with stick-on tape.</div> <div></div>	<div>FUNCTION INSTRUCTION</div> <div><div><div>30</div><div>Smart Delay Start</div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Press button → 30s delay starts</li><li>• Toss into pool (no alarms during placement)</li></ul></div><div><div>Alarm &amp; Silence</div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Triggered alarm: Red flashing light single press → silence</li><li>• Auto-resets to normal monitoring after pause</li></ul></div><div><div>Auto-Reset:</div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• After 30 seconds, alarm reactivates for new triggers.</li></ul></div></div> <div><div>Turn On (Short Press):</div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Press the middle button once.</li><li>• Green light turns on for 10 seconds, then goes off.</li><li>• Alarm is now active.</li></ul><div>Turn Off (Long Press):</div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Press &amp; hold the middle button for 3 seconds. Green light flashes 3 times, then turns off.</li><li>• Alarm is now disabled.</li></ul></div> <div></div> <div><div>Swim Mode</div><div>Activate Swimming Mode:</div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• While powered on, press the right button once.</li><li>• Alarm is temporarily disabled (no alerts triggered).</li></ul><div>Automatic Reactivation:</div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• After leaving the pool, if water stays calm for 10 minutes, the alarm automatically resets to normal mode.</li></ul></div>
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<div>OPERATION INSTRUCTION</div> <div><div><div>1</div></div><div><div>2</div></div><div><div>3</div></div><div><div>4</div></div></div> <div>1. Using the provided kit, tie the string to the pool unit.</div> <div>2. Place the pool unit in the pool away from the pump outlet. Remember to install the 9V battery in the pool unit.</div> <div>3. Install the home unit high up on a wall in dry place that is as close to the pool as possible.</div> <div>4. Press the center on button of the pool unit, then press the button on the left side of the pool equipment, the pool unit and home unit will be connected automatically. Remember to connect the charging plug to the home unit.</div> <div>ALARM PLACEMENT</div> <div>One pool alarm can be used for all pool types. This includes above ground, in-ground, inflatable and soft side pools.</div> <div>Use the placement suggestions in figure to determine the best placement for your pool shape.</div>	<div>SENSITIVITY ADJUST</div> <div>Turning the flotation base clockwise or counterclockwise raises or lowers the sensing ring with respect to the water. The closer the sensing ring is to the water, the more sensitive the alarm.</div> <div>Turn the flotation base gently clockwise until it stops.</div> <div>Note: Sensitivity is preset for optimal performance — do not adjust unless directed by support.</div> <div>Sensitivity Marks</div> <div>The “Sensitivity Marks” can be used as a general indicator for the sensitivity position. Should the sensitivity need to be adjusted start making adjustments by turning the float only a ¼ turn at a time. Test the alarm after each adjustment. We do not recommend turning the float out more than three full turns.</div> <div></div> <div>Low Sensitivity</div> <div>High Sensitivity</div> <div>Sensitivity Marks</div> <div>TROUBLESHOOTING</div> <div>Pool alarm will not work.</div> <div>Low or missing battery. Replace battery with a new 9V alkaline.</div> <div>Pool alarm makes a chirp sound occasionally.</div> <div>The battery voltage may be low. Replace battery with a new 9V alkaline.</div> <div>Pool alarm was working and is now it is not.</div> <div>Oxidation can build up on the sensing post. Lightly clean with steel wool.</div> <div>Pool alarm gives false alarms.</div> <div>Check that the alarm is not near the filter or pump. Be sure the filter inlet is pointed downward.</div> <div>The LED on the receiver does not light.</div> <div>Be sure wall transformer is plugged into a 110VAC outlet and the power jack is plugged into the receiver. Check that the ON/OFF switch is ON.</div>	<div>DAILY MAINTENANCE</div> <div>1.Cleaning</div> <div>For optimal performance, clean your pool alarm monthly (or after heavy use) by: Removing it from water and rinsing thoroughly with fresh water Gently wiping all surfaces with a soft, non-abrasive cloth Ensuring complete drying before reactivation</div> <div>2. Maintenance</div> <div>Battery Replacement</div> <div>Annually replace the 6LR61 battery when the low-battery indicator flashes Always use high-quality lithium batteries for optimal performance</div> <div>Function Testing</div> <div>Conduct weekly tests by dropping the included 5lb weight near the sensor to verify proper alarm activation After severe weather events, inspect and clear any debris that may obstruct the sensor</div> <div>Preventative Care</div> <div>Keep the sensor surface clean from mineral deposits</div> <div>Store spare batteries in a dry, temperature-controlled environment</div> <div>3. Storage</div> <div>For proper off-season storage, remove batteries, rinse and dry all components thoroughly, then store in the original packaging in a dry location maintaining temperatures between 14°F and 122°F (-10°C to 50°C) to ensure optimal performance when reused.</div> <div>4.Warranty Terms</div> <div>This product includes a 1-year limited warranty covering manufacturing defects. The warranty becomes void if: the unit is opened/tampered with, submerged beyond its rated depth, or used with non-approved batteries. Always use manufacturer-recommended 6LR61 batteries to maintain warranty coverage.</div>	<div>USAGE TIPS</div> <div>For optimal performance, place the floating alarm sensor in the center of your rectangular pool to ensure 360° detection coverage and equal sensitivity to all edges.</div> <div>Recommended Placement:</div> <div>Center of Pool (ideal for most rectangular pools)</div> <div>Maximizes 360° detection range</div> <div>Equal sensitivity to all pool edges</div> <div>Avoids "dead zones" near ladders/steps</div> <div>Alternative Positions:</div> <div>1/3 from either end (for large pools &gt;40ft)</div> <div>Never place directly against pool edge/wall (reduces sensitivity by 50%+)</div> <div>Special Cases:</div> <div>Freeform Pools: Position near widest section</div> <div>Above-Ground Pools: Center placement is critical (smaller water area)</div> <div>Multi-Alarm Setup: Place units at opposite ends (for pools &gt;20'x40')</div> <div></div> <div>Looking for How-To Videos?
