Yes, according to FCC KDB 784748 D01 §2.2, if the device is too small or if it is not practical to label it directly, the FCC ID may be placed in the user manual and/or on the packaging. Since your Bluetooth glasses have limited space, it is acceptable to print the FCC ID in the instruction manual.

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
