Installation Tips

The darker area the light is projected, the brighter for the visualization. Try to stay away from areas with street lights or other bright lights.

For the safety purpose, it is strongly recommended that the fixture is properly mounted using a suitable hanging clamp and safety cable if you are going to hang up the products.

Remote Control Instructions



ON/OFF



The settings will be remembered and will remain the same effect next time power on the light



Restore to factory default effect



The starlight Stop/Start rotating



Switch the light color to red

TIMER:

The green light flashes twice to indicate that the timing setting is successful. Press the "CANCEL" button, the red light flashes twice to cancel the timer setting.



Notes:

The light has been designed that the settings of remote control can be remembered when the light be shut down with Power button or the Timer. And if the light be shut down by turned off the power supply, the settings will be reset to the Autorun mode. However, the Timer setting will not be remembered when the light be powered off manually. And must be reset again.

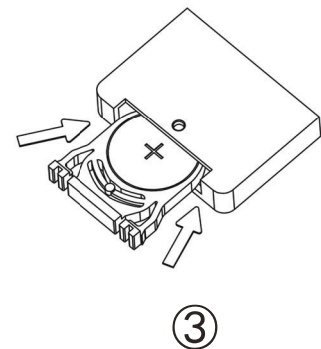
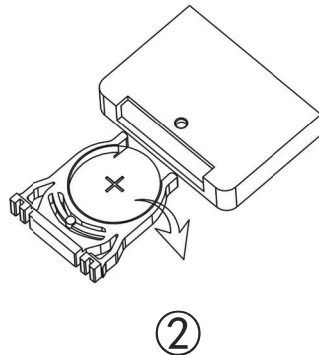
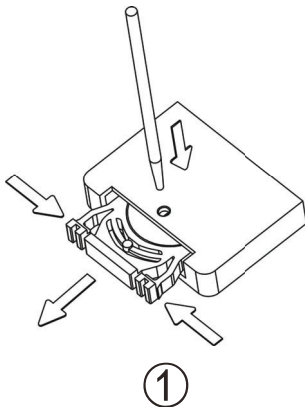
1. Activate the remote control:

Before using the remote for the first time, pull out the insulation tab from the battery compartment on the remote control. Battery has already been installed and will work once tab removed. Save and insert back the tab if no use the light for long time to avoid any battery power leakage;



Replacing Battery(please follow steps as photo shows below):

- ① Pull the battery tray out of the battery compartment;
- ② Place the new CR2025 button cell battery in the tray slot correctly based on the indicated cell polarity.
- ③ Push back the battery tray.






Shall include the statements:

- a) The statement “Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of used batteries according to local regulations and keep away from children. Do NOT dispose of batteries in household trash or incinerate.”
- b) The statement “Even used batteries may cause severe injury or death.”
- c) The statement “Call a local poison control center for treatment information.”
- d) A statement indicating the compatible battery type (e.g., CR2025).

Safety Instruction

Electric safety instructions

Before using any electrical products, basic precautions should always be practiced as below:

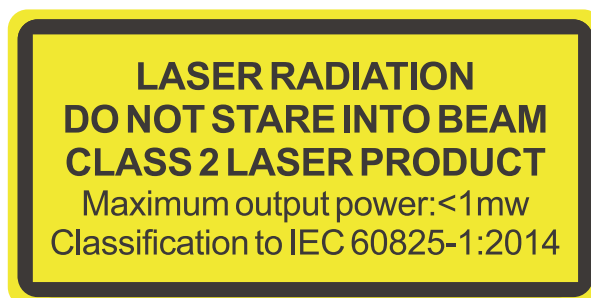
1. Only qualified persons are allowed to do the electrical installation work follow by all applicable codes, standards, procedures, including the fire-rated construction
2. For a direct plug-in power unit, do not install or use within 10 feet of a pool, and not use in a bathroom.
3. Warning: Risk of electric shock and fire. For outdoor use, make sure there is a covered Class A GFCI protected receptacle available. Ensure that the power unit and cord do not interfere with completely closing the receptacle cover. Consult a qualified electrician how to run wiring to avoid fire risk.
4. Don't install it on flammable object. No naked flame sources, such as lighted candles should be placed on the apparatus. Don not use it when maximum ambient temperature is higher than 40 degrees.
5. Unplug the unit when it is not used for longer time more than one month.
6. Do not operate unit with damaged plug.
7. Do not disassemble adapter, otherwise result in a risk of electric shock or fire. Please use the original packing when the device is to be transported.

Laser Safety Warnings

A Class 2 laser is considered safe because of the blink reflex if not viewed through optical instruments. As with class 1, this applies to laser beams with a large diameter or large divergence, for which the amount of light passing through the pupil cannot exceed the limits for class 2.

Attention!

This projector is designed and classified as Class 2 laser product per IEC 60825-1:2014 and Laser safety labels required to comply with the regulation of FDA are stucked on the body.



Safety Instruction

Warning!

1. No attempts to be made to open the protective housing or operate the device if the aperture windows are damaged. Do not open the laser light/housing under any circumstance if any without professional help and neither attempt to repair the light by yourself as the unsafe levels of laser radiation may cause injury/danger.
2. Do not point the light onto any oncoming pedestrians, vehicles or traffic..etc from land, sea, or air...etc.
3. Do not project the laser light at or within the flight path for aircraft. If intended project surface is within 10 nautical miles of airport, please lower the angle of the light, and make sure no any lasers point into the sky or influence the fly for the aircraft.
4. This unit is not intended to use by persons(children included) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of any related product knowledge and experience unless they have been given fully instruction or supervision and their safety was responsible for.
5. Do NOT play by Children as the light is not a toy, all the operations by children MUST be fully supervised by Adults who responsible for their safety.
