The 88-key standard keyboard provides you a real feel of playing on a grand piano.




### Headphone Socket

The external headphone Socket makes it easy to play without affecting others.

### Special Reminder:

This product is an electronic electroacoustic instrument product. It is normal for the speaker (two speakers or one of the speakers, or headphones) to have a slight current sound after being energized. Please keep away from "radios, televisions, antenna receivers, routers, refrigerators, televisions, electrical appliances with motors, etc. from all sources of RF electrical interference" during use.




- ① To 1-4 cross large flat head pointed Tail tapping screw M5X50 (4 PCS)
- ②To 2-4 Cross Large Flat Head Machine Screw M6X50(4 PCS)
- ③ To 3–4 Screw M6X20 with plastic handle (4 PCS)

### Installation Steps:

- 1. Fix the left and right support plates and the middle fixing plate with screws ① PM5  $\times$  50 (4PCS);
- 2. fix the foot pedal beam with screws 2M6x50 (4PCS) at the lower end of the left and right support plates; Before fixing the footrest, be sure to thread the connecting wire on the footpeg through the round hole on the rear side.
- 3. Place the body on the left and right support plates and fix it with screws 3 M6 × 20 (4PCS).

### **CONNECTION JACK**

### Power cord connection

- 1. When using, plug in the power cord as shown in the diagram, insert one end into the power socket in the operation board on the back of the piano, and plug the other end into the 220V household power socket. (Figure 1)
- 2. When this product is not used for a long time, please unplug the power cord and keep it properly.

### Audio input/output plugs

- 1. The audio output jack can be connected to large speaker equipment. (Fig. 2)
- 2. The audio input jack can connect an external sound source to the electric piano for playback. (Fig. 2)

### Headphone jack


Connecting the headphones will automatically cut off the output of the keyboard's built-in speakers, so that you can play without disturbing others. (Fig. 3)

### USB transmission interface

The digital piano can be connected to a computer using the USB port. Through the pre-installed music software on the computer, you can learn or play the keyboard for performance, composition, storage and other functions. The edited music and the accompaniment built into the music software can be played back by connecting to the digital piano through the software, or playing according to the accompaniment music. (Fig. 4)

### Foot pedal connection

Plug the pedal cord end plug into the round socket at the bottom of the piano to turn on 3 pedal sound effects! (Fig. 5)

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### **OPERATION GUIDE**

### Piano performance

- 1. Press and hold "Power", the LCD display lights up, and you can enter the performance state.
- 2. Play the music on the piano keyboard.
- 3. When not in use temporarily, press "Power" to turn off the power.
- The processor chip of this product is complex, similar to the computer system, sometimes it cannot respond, please turn off the power switch and then turn it on to work normally.

### Volume adjustment

Press "Vol+" or "Vol-" to adjust the volume, Please adjust the volume to the desired position.

### 3 Instrument tone selection

- 1. Press "Tone/Rhythm" to enter the tone mode (the default is tone when powered on)
- 2. Press "Select ▲" or "Select ▼" to select any tone, and the LCD will display the corresponding tone number.
- 3. Find the tone you need in the appendix list. There are a total of 128 tones.

### Note! -

 Whenever you power on your digital piano, the initial default is "Piano" tone.

### 4 Rhythm selection

- 1. Press "Tone/Rhythm" to enter the rhythm mode,
- 2. Press "Select ▲" or "Select ▼" to select any rhythm, and the LCD will display the corresponding rhythm number
- 3. Press the tempo "Start/Stop" to start playing the selected tempo.

To stop the rhythm playback, press "Start/Stop" again.

There are a total of 100 rhythms.

4. Find the rhythm you need in the appendix rhythm list.





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### 5 Use chord accompaniment

- 1. Select the rhythm you want to play, refer to the "Rhythm Selection" operation in point 4.
- 2. Press "Chord" to enter the chord state.
- Use single and multi-finger multiplexed chord method, where it conforms to the multi-finger chord playing method, the piano should be multi-finger chord; For multi-finger chords, the response is identified by single-finger chords.
- 3. Play chords on the accompaniment keyboard (keys 1–34 from left) according to different fingerings.
- 4. Press "Chord" again to turn off the chord state

### 6 Synchronous start

Before you begin, first select the rhythm you want to use, set the speed value, and select the chord accompaniment.

- 1. In rhythm mode, press "Sync" to enter the sync start standby mode.
- 2. Play any key and the accompaniment will automatically start playing.
- 3. To cancel the sync status, just press "Start/Stop".

### Metronome function

- 1. Press "Metronome" to activate the metronome function, and the LCD will display the current beat count.
- 2. Press "Select ▲" or "Select ▼" to adjust the metronome, with a total of 4 beats (001–004).
- 3. Press "Metronome" button again to turn off the metronome function.

### Built in demo song

- 1. Press "Demo" to display the current demo song number on the LCD and start playing the demo song. Press the key again to stop.
- 2. In the demo mode, different demo songs can also be selected through "Select ▲" and "Select ▼".

### Note! -

The built-in music library of this product contains 88 songs.
The built-in music can be used to play and enjoy, or you can use the learning function to follow the melody on the keyboard.

### 9 Recording function

1. Keyboard note recording:

Press and hold the "Record/Play" to enter recording mode and play the keys to enter note recording.

Press "Record/Play" again to stop recording. Can record 5000 notes.

2. Sound Playback:


Press "Record/Play" to play the recorded notes.

### 10 Setting functions

- Press "Settings" to enter the keyboard split mode, then press "Settings" to turn on or off the dual keyboard function by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 2. Press "Select ▼" to enter the dual-timbral mode, then press "Settings" to turn on or off the dual-timbral function by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 3. Press "Select ▼" to enter the velocity mode, and then press "Settings" to select different dynamics by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", a total of 5 strengths to choose from Press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 4. Press "Select ▼" to enter the speed mode, then press "Settings" to select a different speed (20-255) by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 5. Press "Select ▼" to enter the rhythm volume mode, then press "Settings" to \ select different rhythm volume (0-32) by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.

- 6. Press "Select ▼" to enter the transpose mode, then press "Settings" to select different transposing (-12--12) by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 7. Press "Select ▼" to enter the equalizer bass mode, and then press "Settings" to select different bass (0-127) by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 8. Press "Select ▼" to enter the equalizer treble mode, then press "Settings" to select different trebles (0-127) by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 9. Press "Select ▼" to enter the chord volume mode, then press "Settings" to select different chord volumes (0-32) by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Back/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 10. Press "Select ▼" to enter the keyboard drum mode, then press "Settings" to choose to turn on or off the drum sound by "Select ▲" or "Select ▼", and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 11. Press "Select ▼" to enter the settings save mode, then press "Settings" to save, and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.
- 12. Press "Select ▼" to enter the call mode, then press "Settings" to call the original saved parameters, and press "Return/Reset" to exit this mode.

### PRODUCT CARE

Please note that this electronic instrument needs basic maintenance

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### Wireless Features

Turn on the power, that is, the wireless function is automatically opened, wireless connection password:8888

- 1. Wireless audio function: Use the APP playback of cell phone learning machine and other devices with wireless function to connect the electric piano through the wireless function, you can realize playing music and enjoying songs on the electric piano.
- 2. MIDI Data Function: Using the Play Along APP of a cell phone learning machine or other device and connecting it to the electric piano via a MIDI data cable, you can play along and practice songs on the electric piano.

### 12 Reset

Press and hold the "Back/Reset" to return to the initial state of function.

### Avoid heat, moisture or direct sunlight

and good care to enhance its service life

Do not overexpose the product to direct sunlight, or place it near air conditioning, or in extremely hot places.

#### Do not use near TV or radio

This product may cause video or audio interference to TV and radio reception. If this happens, the product should be removed from the TV or radio.

## **Troubleshooting**

Faults	Possible Causes/Solutions		
When the power is switched on, a popping sound is generated	This is normal, don't worry		
When the power is turned on, the keyboard does not make any sound when pressed	Make sure the master volume control is set in the proper position. O check if other devices are connected to the headphone output jack, so the built-in speaker system automatically disconnects		
There is a slight difference in sound quality between notes in the same tone	This is a normal phenomenon. Different sound quality is produced due to differences in the range of timbre sampling		
When using the tenuto function, some tones have a long tenuto, while others have a short delay	This is a normal phenomenon because the tenuto of the different timbre of this piano has been set as the optimal length		
The volume is too low	Confirm that the master volume control is set in the right position		
Some MIDI data does not transfer properly (even when the MIDI cable is fully connected)	This is a normal phenomenon and is related to the initial settings of this piano		
When using a mobile phone or mobile phone close to it, the speaker of the piano will make noise	Mobile phone opportunities are disruptive. To avoid this kind of noise, you can turn off your mobile phone or use it away from the phone		
When playing, the pitch emitted by the keyboard does not match the position of the keyboard	Perhaps you have turned on the dual keyboard or transposition function.  At this point, just turn off the dual keyboard or move the reset to zero; you can also turn off the power switch and restart.
