II.Introduction and operation of the main page features



1.Home key

Tap this key to return to the main interface.

2.Volume key

Tap the volume key to view volume status. Adjust volume, toggle mute, or check current settings.

3.Car play mode icon

Tap the AUTO PLAY button to open CarPlay and Android AUTO.

4.Time display

Displays the current system time; Tap it to switch the clock format/digital format display.

5.Android AUTO mode icon

Tap the AUTO PLAY button to open Android AUTO.

6.Radio mode icon

Tap the radio mode icon to enter the radio operation interface.

7.Setting mode icon

Tap the setting mode icon to enter the setting mode for operation.

8.APP mode icon

Enter the menu and select "Multi-Function".

9.Bluetooth mode icon

Tap the Bluetooth mode icon to enter the Bluetooth operation interface.

10.USB mode icon

Tap the USB mode icon to enter the USB operation interface.

11.EQ

Tap the mode icon of EQ to enter the operation interface of EQ.

12.IOS Mirror mode icon

Tap the mode icon of IOS Mirror to enter the operation interface of IOS Mirror.







13.Auto Link

Tap this key to enter mirror link interface following the steps on screen to use wired mirror link.

14.AV IN mode icon

Tap the AV IN mode icon to enter the AV IN operation interface.

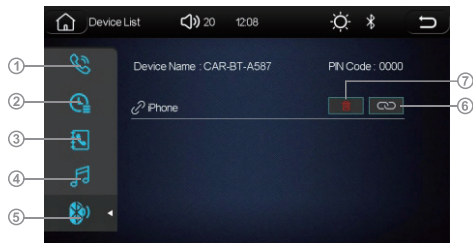
III.Introduction to radio features and operation

1.  Tap this key to browse the stored station information; long-tap this key for one second to search the station from the lowest to the highest frequency, and save the searched information to the search list, and the list will be refreshed and replaced;
2.  Tap this key to cycle through FM > AM > FM modes;
3.  Tap this key to switch to stereo/mono;
4.  Tap this key to toggle remote/near distance;
5.  Tap this key. The frequencies can be moved backward, long-touch for one second to search backward, and automatically stop when a valid station is found.
6.  Tap this key. The frequencies can be moved forward, long-touch for one second to search forward, and automatically stop when a valid station is found.
7. Radio Storage Area. 18 stations can be stored in FM and 12 in AM; (AM function is optional).

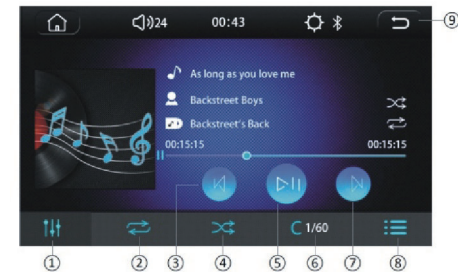
1. Tap to open Bluetooth pairing interface.

6. Remove paired device from the list.
7. Tap this key to disconnect the connected phone \ reconnect the phone to Bluetooth;

VI.Function introduction and operation of Phone link

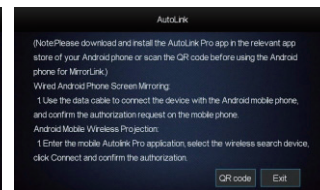
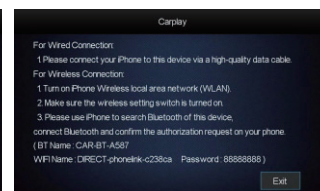
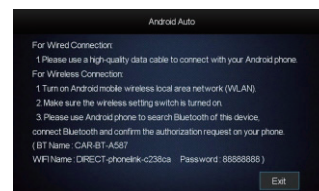
Note: In order to use the cell phone connection function, you need to select the connection method on the vehicle side first.

Introduction to Phone link's functions: When using an Android phone for wired phone interconnection, the phone needs to turn on "USB Debugging" in "Developer Options"; when using an Android phone for wireless phone interconnection, you need to turn on the phone's "Wireless Casting" function to search for the device, and then click on the name of the device when you find it to connect wirelessly; When using iPhone for wireless phone interconnection, the phone should first connect to the WIFI of the car side, that is, open the WIFI function of the phone side to connect to the WIFI of the car side, and then click on the screen image of the phone side to search for the device, search for the target device and click on the name to achieve wireless connection;

1.  Tap this key to enter the interface of Android device wired phone interconnection function;
2.  Tap this key to enter the interface of wired mobile interconnection for Apple devices;
3.  Tap this key to enter the wired CAR PLAY interface;
4.  Tap this key to enter the Android auto interface;







Common problems when using the cell phone interconnect function:

2. Some Android phones need to be touched in Mobile > Application Management > Auto link > Open "Force full screen display";

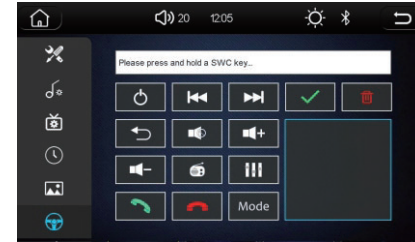


VII. Introduction and operation of setting menu function

6.  Tap this key to enter the direction control setting interface;

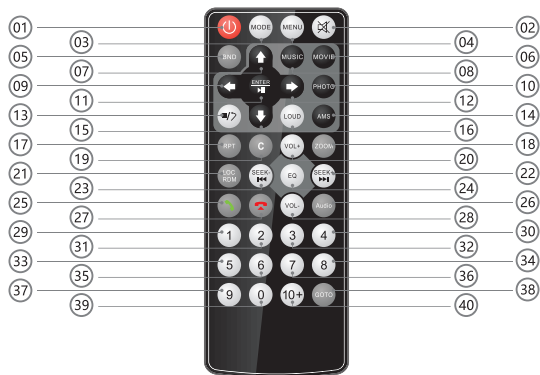
VIII. Brief introduction and operation of learning function of direction control



Matching Method

- Step 1: Access the steering wheel control module from the radio's main menu.
- Step 2: Press and hold the buttons on the steering wheel, such as volume +, press and hold the steering wheel buttons, and then click the volume + on the radio's screen, through learning, the button functions on the steering wheel and the touch screen button functions of the radio will match.
- Step 3: Follow the above steps to match all the button functions. In case of wrong match, you can erase the match record and start again with the correct match through the radio steering wheel control settings.

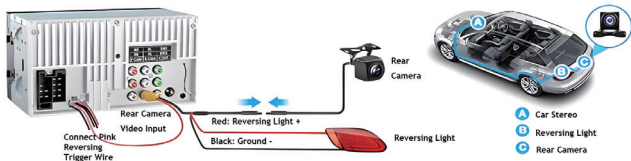

FAQ

1. The device does not power on.
Ensure the power cables are connected with correct polarity (positive/negative).
on the other hand, check whether the fuse is burned, it's better send us photos to show in order to solve the problem.
2. Black screen or shutdown automatically.
It may lost software, so please check the date of production on the PK board.
we can provide the right software to update after know the date of production.
3. No sound.
Check wiring diagram, make sure the connection is right.
4. The button doesn't work.
Check whether the keys have stuck.
5. The radio doesn't work.
Check whether the connection of radio antenna is right.
6. Radio scans continuously and cannot lock onto stations.
The local radio signal may be too weak, try to search the station hardly.
