

Instruction Manual

Please remove the blue insulating sticker on the headset before use. Please charge the headset before use and use it after it is full!
Please read the following instructions carefully before using the product!

1:Pairing method

Take out the headset from the charging box, then the headset will automatically turn on the power and pairing; when one headset indicator light flashes and the other goes out, it means that the headset pairing is successful, and the headset will have voice prompts, open the BT function of your cell phone, search for "TWS" and click connect.

Without charging case, press and hold the touch area of both headsets for 3 seconds, when you hear the "power on" sound and the headset light flashes, it means the headset is on. When both headsets are turned on, they will be paired automatically, and the indicator light of one of the headsets will turn off, which means that the two headsets have been paired successfully. Open the BT function of your cell phone, search for "TWS" and click connect.

2:Function Introduction

Power on/off; remove the headset from the charging case or long press the headset touch area for 3 seconds to turn on the headset, put it into the charging case to turn off the headset automatically or long press the headset touch area for 5 seconds to turn off the headset.

Voice assistant; long press the touch area for 2 seconds to wake up voice.

Play/Pause; Click the left or right headphone touch area to pause playback; click the left or right headphone touch area to continue playback during the pause process.

Volume + / -: double-click the right ear volume +, double-click the left ear volume - (volume maximum or minimum with a tone).

Previous song / next song: Continuously touch the left ear touch area 3 times to play the previous song; Continuously touch the right ear touch area 3 times to play the next song.

Answer/hang up: when there is an incoming call, click the left or right headset touch area to answer the call; when talking, click the left or right headset touch area to hang up the call.

Reject call: When there is an incoming call, long press the left or right ear touch area for 2 seconds to reject the call.

Charging operation:

1. Charge the charging box: Insert one end of the charging cable into the port of the charging box and the other end into the charger to charge the charging box. The charging box will show the current remaining power of the charging box, when the power of the charging box shows OK, the charging is completed.

2. Charge the headset: put the headset into the charging case to charge automatically, the charging case will show the current charging status of the headset, the headset indicator and screen are always on when charging, and the indicator and screen are off when full.
