1). Home page



- 1 Back key, home button, task key.
- 2 Status bar: displays the status of time, WLAN, positioning, Bluetooth, USB, etc.
- 3 Date & Time Settings: Click to go to the Date & Time Settings page
- Background playback status bar: Click to enter the background playback mode page.

- Bluetooth Music Mode: Tap to enter the Bluetooth music playback page.
- Video playback mode: Click to go to the video playback page.
- Screensaver mode: Tap to enter screen saver mode/tap again to open the display.
- Screen off mode: Tap to turn off the display/turn on the display.
- Settings menu: Click on the Android settings page.
- 10 Navigation mode: Tap to enter navigation mode.
- 11 Radio Mode: Click to enter the radio playback page.
- More app interfaces: Click to enter the more app interface.
- Bluetooth phone mode: Click to enter the Bluetooth phone page.

2), Drop-down menu

Swipe your finger down the top edge to trigger a drop-down menu page; On the drop-down menu page, scroll down again and pull up the brightness adjustment.




- Brightness bar: Swipe left and right to adjust the brightness of the screen.

3)、Radio




- 1 Band switching: Switching between FM1/FM2/FM3.

- Save List: Manually save/automatically save the list for the station.






- Folder: Click to go to the folder page that contains the music files.

Voice wake-up: Please say, "Hey top", Or tap the voice button.


After the voice control function wakes up, please say the corresponding playback function after voice recognition.


8), Bluetooth music

11)、Wallpaper




In the wallpaper app, you can customize the wallpaper of the desktop and more apps;

12), Reversing rear view




When the system is running and reversing is turned on in any state, the system can automatically switch to the reversing screen, and will switch back to the pre-reversing state after reversing.
