Place the headset on your head. 2. Position the speaker directly on your ear. You can slide the headband to find the best fit for stability and comfort. 3. You can bend the microphone boom to position the microphone about one finger's width away from your face at the corner of your mouth. 4. The microphone boom supports 270 degrees of rotation so that you can position the headset on either ear.</p>	<h3>Pairing</h3> <h4>How to pairing</h4> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Press and hold on the "MFB" button to power on, a voice prompt "Power on, Pairing" with the indicator light flashes blue-red alternately.2. Turn on the Bluetooth of the second device, search and click "M100", a voice prompt "Your Headset is connected" with the Indicator light off.3. Turn on the Bluetooth of the first device, search and click "M100" (Some mobile phones have an automatic connection feature.), so that successfully connect two devices at the same time.  <p>NOTE a. After the headset is disconnected from the phone, it will automatically enter the pairing state and shut down after 5 minutes. b. When there is a pairing record, just power on, and the headset will automatically connect to the phone.</p>	<h3>How to pairing two device at the same time</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. After the first device is successfully connected, turn off the Bluetooth of the first device and the headset will re-enter the pairing state with the indicator light flashing blue-red alternately.2. Turn on the Bluetooth of the second device, search and click "M100", the pairing is successful with the indicator light off.3. Turn on the Bluetooth of the first device, search and click "M100" (Some mobile phones have an automatic connection feature.), so that successfully connect two devices at the same time.  <p>NOTE Only one of the successfully connected mobile phones A and B can play music. Whichever one starts playing first will continue playing. To play music on the other phone, you must pause or turn off the music on the first phone.</p>	<h3>Power On/Off</h3>  <p>Power on: Press MFB button for 3s, the indicator light flashes blue 3 times with a voice prompt "Power On".</p> <p>Power off: Press MFB button for 5s, the indicator light flashes red 1s with a voice prompt "Power Off".</p>

Audio Switching: Press and hold the "MFB" button for 1s to switch the audio between the phone and the headset. Mute/Unmute: Press once the "Mute" button. Redial Calls: Double press the "MFB" button. Voice Dialing/Siri: Press and hold the "MFB" button for 1s.</p>	<h3>Music</h3>  <p>Play/Pause: Press once the "MFB" button. Volume Up: Press once the "... " button. If it fails, please re-pair and connect. M100 can reconnect within 5 minutes, if more than 5 minutes will be turned off.</p> <h4>Q: How can I delete the paired record?</h4> <p>A: Press and hold the MFB and Volume + buttons for 5 seconds to clear the pairing record. After deletion, M100 will not connect the device automatically.</p> <h4>Q: What is the password for pairing?</h4> <p>A: Some connected devices need password for pairing, please try 0000 or 8888 or 1111 or 1234.</p> <h4>Q: What devices can charge the headset?</h4> <p>A: Any car charger, portable charger, computer, etc. that meets DC 5V and has a charging current greater than 500mA can charge the M100.</p> <h4>Q: If there is a connection problem or dead, what should I do?</h4> <p>A: Please try charging reset, the operation method: plug in the charging cable charging, the headset reset to the off state, the power on can be used normally, if still can not be used normally, you can seek technical support from us at Amazon.</p> <h4>Q: My headset automatically shut down?</h4> <p>A: If more than 5 minutes without connecting any device, or the battery voltage is lower than 3.1V, H1 will automatically shut down.</p>	<h3>Safety</h3> <p>IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTE: Prolonged exposure to high volume levels can damage your hearing.
