

This product is not sold with a power adapter. If consumers use a power adapter for power supply, they should purchase a matching power adapter that has obtained CCC certification and meets standard requirements. The output specifications of the adapter should comply with DC5V/2A



Main

1. Aux-in
2. DC 5V
3. TF
4. Long press for including voice, short press for previous song
5. Long press for including voice, short press for next song

2. DC 5V charging
4. Long press 3s for Power on/Power off
6. short press for pause/playing
8. short press for change the model

Manual for bluetooth

1. Open phone, the normal model is bluetooth, and the blue LED flash for waiting pair
2. Open the phone, enter the mobile device menu option, find the Bluetooth function option and click "searching", waiting until the product model is found and connected
3. LED model Two press the 'M' button

Line in

Use 3.5mm line to connect speaker and player, then the speaker can change to the line in model

Led for charging

When charging, the red light on, the light is off when the speaker is fully charged

TF Model

When insert the TF/SD card in, the speaker can change to TF model and play the song which is in the card

Instruction for wireless microphone

Long press the power button, the speaker and wireless can pair successfully; Then long press the power button the wireless microphone power off

Microphone Instructions

Tap and hold	Power-off
Short press	Mode/Reverberation/ Accompaniment/ Microphone adjustment
Short press	Mode/Reverberation/ Accompaniment/ Microphone Gradually increase the volume
Short press	Mode/Reverberation/ Accompaniment/ Microphone Gradually increase the volume
Short press	Sound effect mode/Girl to boy/ Boy to girl/Doll sound/Magic sound
Double-click	Original/elimination sound



Note:

The microphone should not be within 10 centimeters of the speaker to avoid noise.
