

## IMPORTANT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

When using your mouse, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

8. Keep this manual and all relevant information for future reference.
9. Clean your mouse using a soft cloth or paper towel. Do not use harsh chemicals when cleaning your mouse, and never submerge your mouse in water.

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Vivitar Animal Wireless Mouse, item FBWM1300. Your wireless mouse can come in three different animal shapes: Cow, Pig, and Whale. A 2.4GHz USB receiver is included with your mouse. Please read this manual carefully FIRST in order to get the most out of your mouse.

## INSERTING THE BATTERY

In order to operate your mouse successfully, you will need to insert 1 AAA battery (not included). To do so, follow the steps below.

1. Open the battery compartment located on the bottom of the mouse.
2. Insert 1 AAA battery inside the battery compartment, making sure to insert it with the correct polarity (+,-) as shown on the battery compartment.
3. Once your battery is properly inserted, place the cover back onto the mouse.

For best results, always use new alkaline batteries.

### BATTERY WARNING:

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Batteries are not to be inserted with the wrong polarity.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Please recycle or dispose of the battery properly. Contact local recycling facilities and/or the manufacturer of your battery for further information.

## MOUSE SETUP

To connect your mouse to your computer, follow the steps below:

1. Take out the USB receiver from the that is located on the rear of your mouse as its tail.
2. Insert the USB receiver into one of your computer's USB ports.
3. Make sure that your computer is powered on.
4. To power on, slide the power switch located on the bottom of your mouse to the ON position, and to power off, slide the power switch to the OFF position.

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## NOTES

-The mouse will stop working once you pull the receiver out of the USB port or when the computer is turned off.

-You can store your mouse's USB receiver inside your mouse, making it more portable and easy to store when not in use.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Mouse is not working properly, please try the following:

- Make sure that both your mouse and your computer are powered on.
- Make sure the distance between the two devices is less than 10m.
- Make sure that your computer has suitable drivers for recognizing a USB mouse.
- Make sure the batteries in your mouse have been inserted correctly.
