Dear Mr. Dichoso:

Pursuant to your email request for a revised cellular image rejection test, I am providing by separate file under Test Reports a Revised Cellular Image Rejection data sheet. This test has been performed exactly to your instructions contained in the email correspondence referenced above.

Just for your reference, by calculating the worst case conditions and performing actual image rejection measurements on this device, we were able to determine the following:


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The reason for these exceptional results is obviously because the referenced scanner does not have any tuning capability above 512 MHz. However, we felt that you would be interested in these measurements.

Additionally, as we discussed by telephone, it is our position that the circuitry in the subject device has been designed so that it is inaccessible for the purpose of being modified to receive transmissions from the Cellular Telephone Service. We claim that the changing of components, including the tuning, control, and filtering circuitry, to enable the interception of cellular band transmissions is virtually impossible.
