I have a few comments on this Application.

- 1 The internal photos must clearly and unambiguously show the content and components of the circuit boards. The photos provided are not clear. Please provide clear and focused photos of the internal boards. For larger boards, it may be necessary to take pictures in 'quadrants' of the whole board.
- 2 Please provide a clearer explanation of what the changes are. While a summary of changes has been provided, a more detailed explanation would be good.
- 3 Please note that the original grant listed a power of 54 W. A permissive change cannot change the power of a device per 2.1043 "Except as provided in paragraph (b)(3) of this section, changes to the basic frequency determining and stabilizing circuitry (including clock or data rates), frequency multiplication stages, basic modulator circuit **or maximum power or field strength** ratings shall not be performed without application for and authorization of a new grant of certification." While the power in the PC2 and the power on the original grant are within 0.5dBm of each other, it is still not possible to change the power rating on the original grant using a PC2. The PC2 grant must reflect the original in all aspects dealing with frequency, modulation and power. The test report used in this PC2 can, however, have minor variances within manufacturing tolerances. Please clarify and/ or verify that the changes to the system did not change the power output level of the system from the original grant. Also, please verify that the power level on the original grant is to be the same as on the PC2.
