Re: Identification Change - RadioFrame Networks Product FCC IDs changed to Motorola FCC IDs

Per CFR 47, Paragraph 2.933, Motorola respectfully requests change in identification for the indicated transmitters. Separate filing packages will follow for each transmitter.

Motorola has purchased some of the assets of a company that has FCC type accepted equipment. This company is known as RadioFrame Networks (RFN). The existing transmitters affected are as follows:

For each of these existing FCC IDs, the grantee code is being changed from RFN's grantee code of "PUR", to Motorola's grantee code of "ABZ". The product code is unchanged.

There is no change in design, circuitry, or construction of the unit other than the company logos and labeling.

This application package consists of the following:

- (1) The original identification used
- (2) The date of the original grant
- (3) How the equipment bearing the modified identification differs from the original equipment
- (4) Whether the original test results continue to be representative / applicable
- (5) Exterior appearance photographs


No resubmission of equipment or measurement data is required unless specifically requested by the commission.
