To Whom It May Concern:

The Base Model WX-C3010 is a DECT radio device operating in the 1920-1930MHz band (UPCS). It is used as a base unit operating in drive-thru or in quick service restaurant. The communication is controlled by the crews or manager of the quick service restaurant.

The Base Unit communicates with its associated: (1) All-In-One Wireless Headset Model WX-H3050, which was FCC Part 15D certified under FCC ID: ACJ9TAWX-H3050; and (2) Wireless Order Taker Model WX-T3020, which was FCC Part 15D certified under FCC ID: ACJ9TAWX-T3020.

Personnel trained would install this radio device for the configuration covered by this Class II Permissive Change II Change application (i.e configuration with additional antenna for extended coverage outside building). The FCC Part 15 requirements will be followed by the personnel trained by Panasonic Corporation of North America.

Further, Panasonic Corporation of North America will not distribute, market or sell to the general public any part of the subject base station and/or its associated system parts.
