To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of Panasonic Corporation of North America, we hereby authorize PCTEST Engineering Laboratory, Inc., to act on our behalf in matters relating to FCC equipment authorization, including the signing of documents relating to these matters. Any and all acts carried out by PCTEST on our behalf shall have the same effect as acts of our own.

This project represents Portable Handheld Wireless Display, Model CF-08mk1 with Intel CPU type PXA270 at 312 MHz clock speed to be marketed under FCC ID: ACJ9TGCF-081. This product will be marketed with the following two co-located transmitters: (1) Murata Bluetooth Model LBMA46LBA3 with Part 15C operation within 2402~2480 MHz at 19 mW conducted output; and (2) Sychip 2.4 GHz WLAN(b), Model WLAN6065EBC2-HL-TR-01 with Part 15C operation within 2412~2462 MHz at 33.2 mW conducted RF output.

This product's LCD may be operated in either portrait and landscape configuration. The highest reported SAR values at zero spacing between antenna-to-body were: (1) Bluetooth in Tablet Body Position was .181 w/kg; and (2) WLAN in Tablet Body Position was 1.24 W/kg.

This PC contains BlueTooth TX/RX Pattern Inverted F-type antenna with 2.44 dBi max antenna gain and WLAN TX/RX Pattern Inverted F-type antenna with max 2.0 dBi antenna gain.

In accordance with provisions of Section 0.457(d) of the Commission's Rules and Section 552(b)(4) of the Freedom of Information Act, we request permanent confidentiality for transmitter's exhibits which contain Operation Description, Parts Lists, Block Diagram and Schematic Diagram. The BT and WLAN transmitters are not user adjustable and are not provided with Tune-Up Procedure. These exhibits contain proprietary, confidential and trade secrets material, which would not be routinely made available for public inspection. Also, in accordance with FCC Public DA 04-1705, we request short-term confidentiality for exhibits which contain External Photographs, Internal Photographs and User Manual. These exhibits contain pre-market information, which could give our competitors unfair advantage should this information be released before this product is actually introduced into the common marketplace.
