 - 2.) Please be sure users manual has appropriate statements warning users to maintain a 20 cm distance from the EUT and the body (excluding extremities: hands, wrists, and feet).
 - 3.) Please identify antenna(s) used with this device by model or part number, gain, and manufacturer.
 - 4.) The first of two *.jpg files submitted for the external view is a bit fuzzy. Could you please resubmit larger, clearer photo?
 - 5.) The following Grant note will appear on this device. Please note this equipment meets the legal definition of a "Mobile" device for the purposes of RF exposure.
- The antenna(s) used for this transmitter must be installed to provide a separation distance of at least 20 cm from all persons and must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter. End-users and installers must be provided with antenna installation instructions and transmitter operating conditions for satisfying RF exposure compliance.

Please note the 20 cm distance is between the body and EUT only excluding extremities (hands and feet).

This is the only error I can find with this Application. Once solved, I will issue a Grant immediately.
