This is in response to your request for additional information.

1. Please provide an example of the "individual provided supplement instructions", referenced in the user's manual, which lists the maximum antenna gains permitted for compliant operation.
Answer: Refer to e-mail attachment with optional Car Mounter supplement information with recommended external antenna gains.
2. Please provide a photo that shows a minimum separation distance of 20 cm for the WWAN and WLAN transmit antennae (in order to justify the mobile classification).
Answer: Refer to e-mail attachment with marked-up antenna location photographs. All transmitter antennas are located greater than 20 cm between all the antennas and all person's body (excluding extremities of hands, wrist and feet) during wireless modes of operation.
3. Please verify compliance with Section 15.407(c). If this information already resides in the Operational Description, please specify its location therein.
Answer: Refer to separately provided confidential documents, which includes description how NII transmitter automatically discontinue transmission in case of either absence of information to transmit or operational failure.
4. FYI: in the future, please be sure that the block diagram(s) for the licensed transmitters shows all of the clocks/oscillators, as required by the Rules.
Answer: I have again requested that required block diagrams and schematic diagrams be upgraded to reflect all of the employed clock/oscillator frequencies. However, as of today I have not yet received such updated documents.
