To whom it may concern:

Pursuant to CFR § 2.1043, Panasonic Corporation of North America hereby requests a Class II Permissive Change for its application with FCC ID: ACJ9TGWW12D2, which was granted on December 21, 2012 by Compliance Certification Services.

This authorization only covers the Class II permissive change application for the following changes:

- Mobile to Portable Classification.
- Installation into Panasonic Tablet PC with proximity sensor (Model: FZ-G1).
- The CDMA BC1/LTE mode sof WW12D2 used in the Host PC FZ-G1 are specially programmed and tuned to operate at a lower power setting than the original maximum power to ensure that the output power does not exceed the targets described in the SAR report.
- Collocation with 802.11a/b/g/n + BT Half Minicard with pre-existing FCC ID ACJ9TGWL12A, whose SAR test data is included in this application.
- Decrease in Frequency/Band Capability; Per KDB178919 (4.b) GSM/UMTS functionality has been removed via a fixed & permanent software change. The WW12D2 used in the Host PC FZ-G1 will only support CDMA Bc0/BC1, and LTE Band 13.
- No other radio parameters have been changed.
