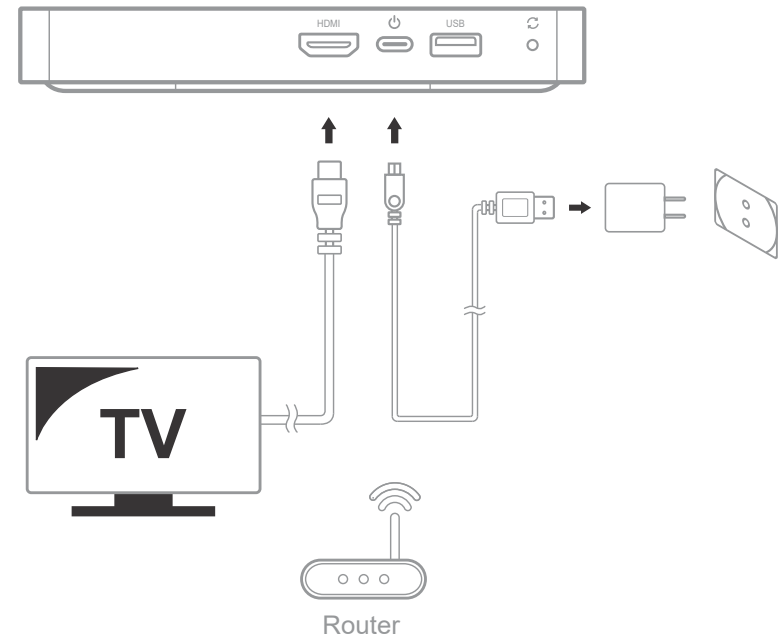
Set Up Device

Before you start, confirm you have:

- A Wi-Fi internet connection.
- A Google account.
 - A Google account is recommended but not required. The user will be able to skip the Google 'sign in' step.

Step1

1. Connect the HDMI cable from your Stream TV to your TV.
2. Connect the power cord from your Stream TV to an electrical outlet.
3. Turn on your TV.
4. Set your TV to the correct HDMI input.
 - Refer to the TV manufacturer for help verifying HDMI input.
5. Pair your Stream TV Voice Remote as described in pairing screen

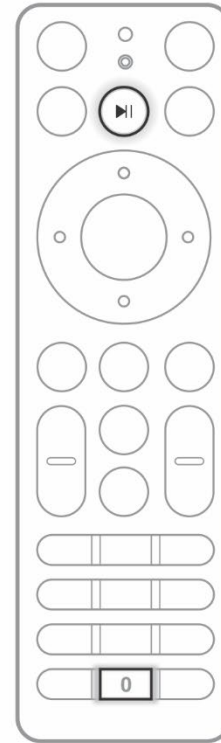


Pairing Your Stream TV Voice Remote

1. Press and hold the Remote "Play/Pause" and "0" buttons simultaneously for 6 seconds.
2. Release the buttons to enter pairing mode.
3. If the 'pairing your remote' screen doesn't display, place the Stream TV in Bluetooth® discovery mode with the existing voice remote

Pairing your remote


Press and hold the “Play/Pause” and “0” buttons simultaneously for 6 seconds. Release to enter pairing mode.

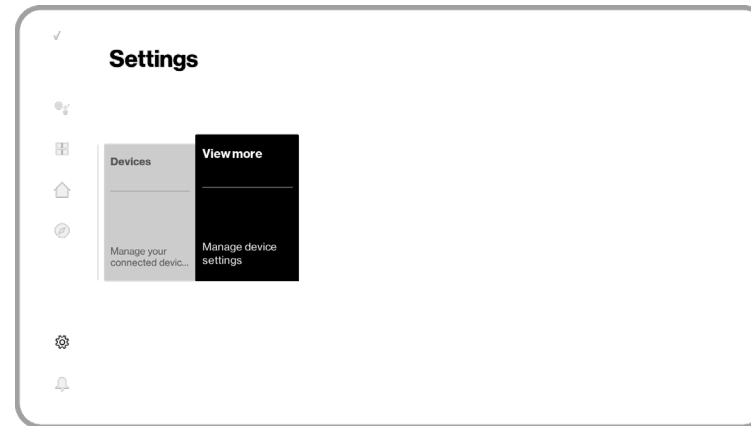
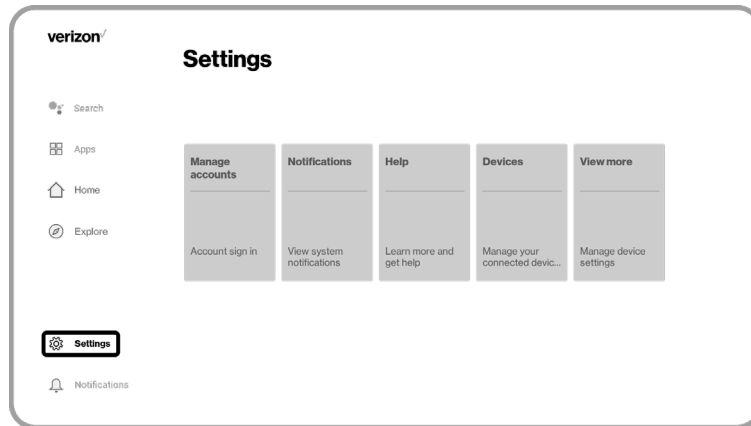

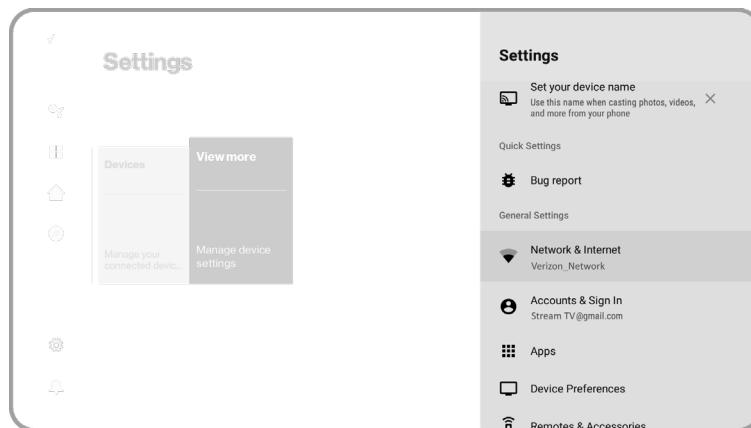

Manually Add a Wi-Fi Network

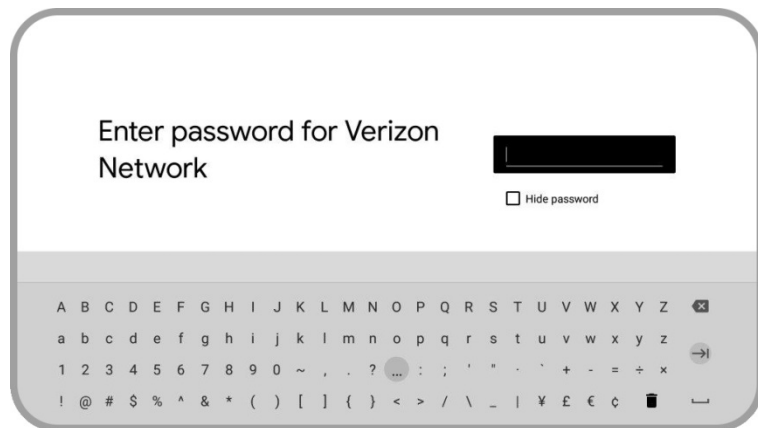
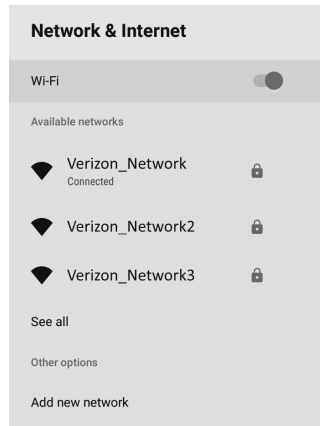
1. From the Stream TV Home screen, select the Settings menu 
 - Utilize 5-way navigation pad on the remote to highlight and the center (OK) button to select.
2. Select View more



3. Select Network & Internet 



4. From the 'Available networks' section, select the preferred Wi-Fi network.
→ If the preferred network is not listed, it can be added manually.
5. If presented, enter the appropriate password then select CONNECT.



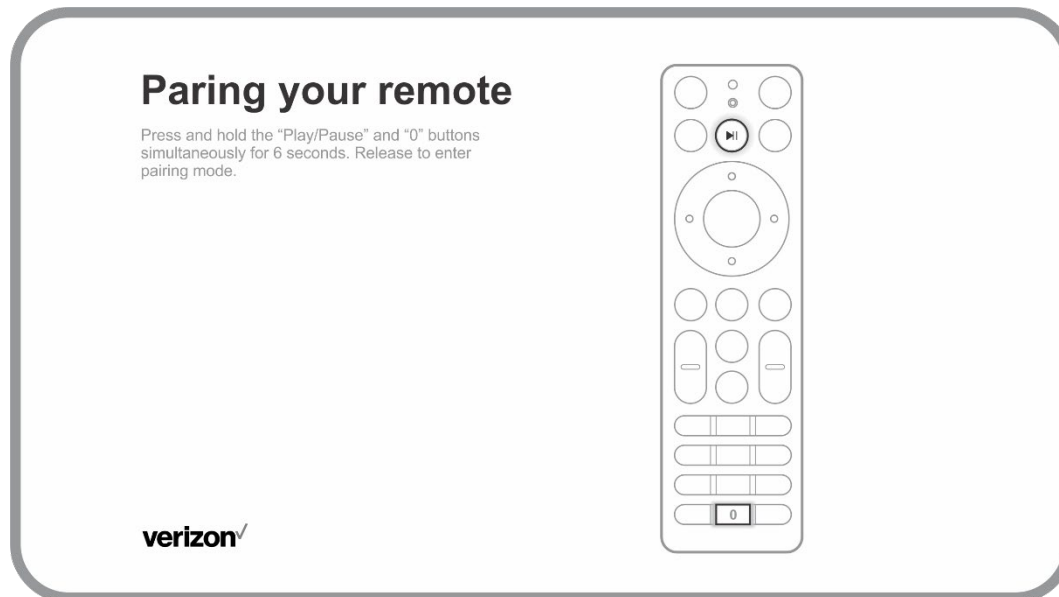
Manually Pairing Your Stream TV Voice Remote

Note: Only needed when replacing previously paired Stream TV Voice Remote

1. Press and hold the Top button for 3 seconds.



2. Press and hold the "Play/Pause" and "0" buttons on remote control simultaneously for 6 seconds.
3. Release the buttons to enter pairing mode.
4. If the 'pairing your remote' screen doesn't display, place the Stream TV in Bluetooth® discovery mode with the existing voice remote or the remote control app.

BT pairing → Press and hold top button for 3 seconds for manually pairing

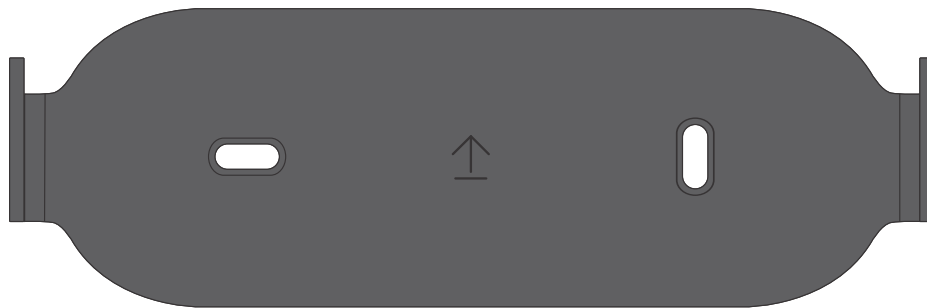
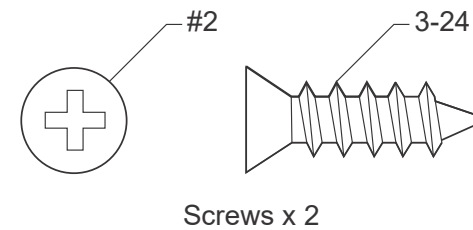

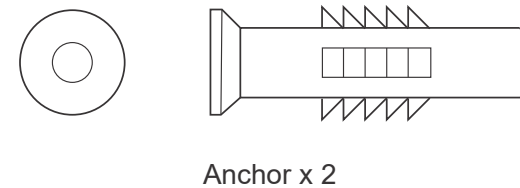
WALL MOUNTING Information

The device can be mounted onto a flat surface such as a wall or the back of a TV.
For wall mounting, the device must not be mounted higher than 2 meters above the floor.

Inside the product package for the outdoor mounting bracket, you should find the following:

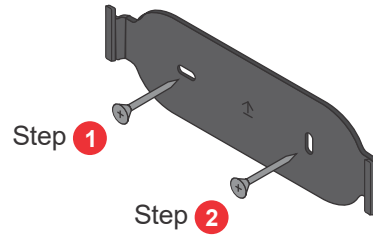


Wall mount bracket x 1

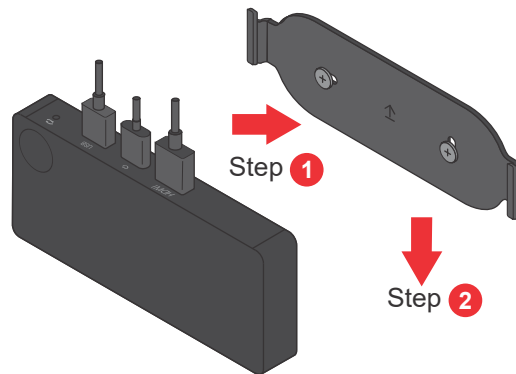


WALL MOUNTING Install Guidance 1

1. Using 2pcs screws to fix bracket onto wall



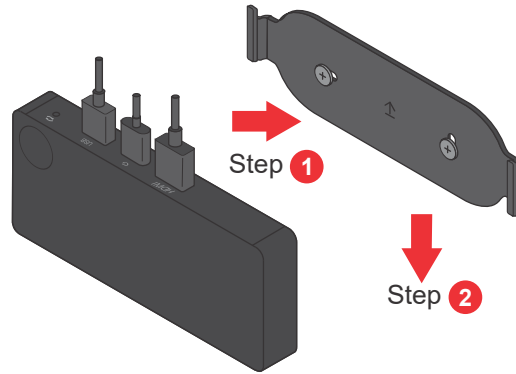
2. Assemble with bracket



To make sure the device is seated properly, users will feel a “click”

WALL MOUNTING Install Guidance 2

1. Assemble with bracket



2. Tear off the release papers of two adhesive strip (**the adhesives are intended to be used once**)



3. Mount onto wall



Regulatory Information
