

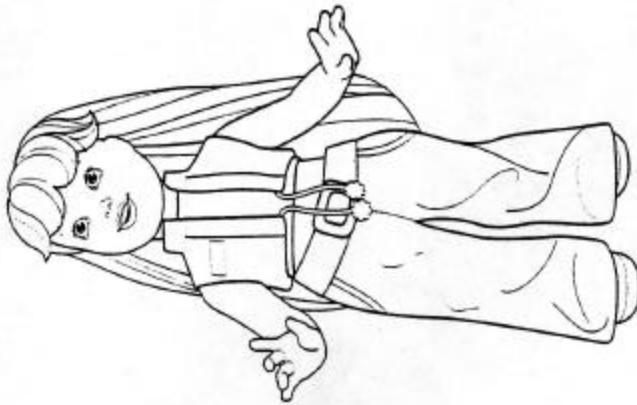

Please remove everything from the package and compare to the contents shown here. If any items are missing, please call 1-800-524-TOYS.

Keep these instructions for future reference as they contain important information. **ADULTS NOTE:** Cut the plastic attachments with scissors and discard pieces.

Requires 4 "AAA" and 4 "C" alkaline batteries (not included).

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For best results:

1. Keep the controller at 10 feet or less from the doll for best performance.
2. Operating multiple dolls with the same frequency in close proximity will cause interference and poor performance.
3. Works best away from high voltage power lines, large buildings, and walls.
4. When the doll does not respond, slows down, or the volume decreases, replace the batteries.

INSTALL BATTERIES

Controller Batteries

1. Swing belt clip up.
2. Unscrew battery door screw with Phillips screwdriver (not included), and remove door.
3. Insert four (4) "AAA" alkaline batteries as shown. Replace door.

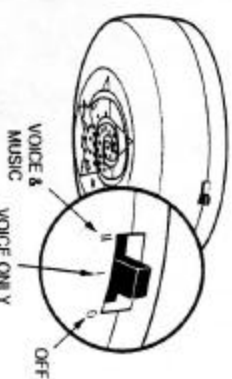
Doll Batteries

1. Lift doll's pant legs to change batteries. Replace batteries when motion slows or sound becomes garbled.
2. Unscrew and remove battery door. Raise holder. Insert "C" alkaline battery.
3. Lower the holder and insert second "C" alkaline battery. Replace door. Repeat for other leg.

BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION:

1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before they are charged.
3. If removable rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.
4. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
5. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries.
6. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
7. Be sure to insert batteries with the correct polarities and always follow the toy and battery manufacturers' instructions.
8. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.
9. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
10. Dispose of batteries safely.

Be sure that controller is within 10 feet of doll.



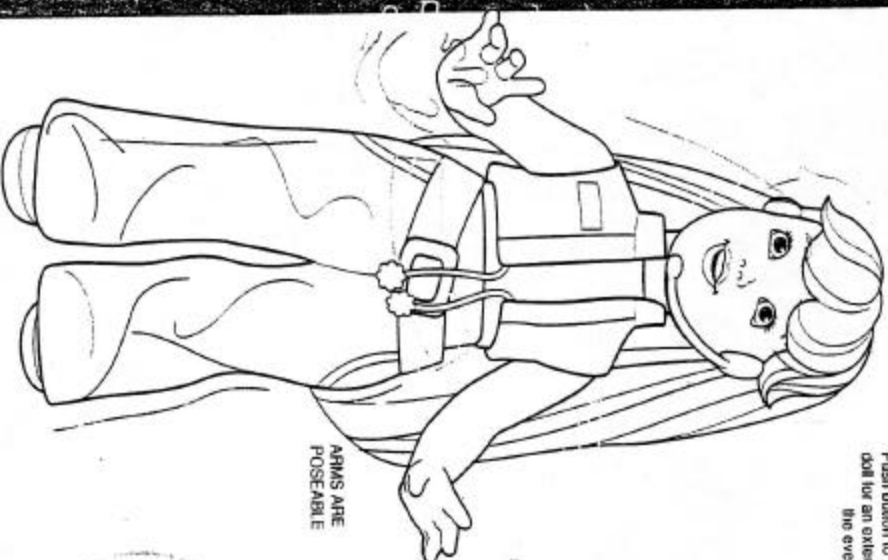
ON/OFF BUTTON

Push button inward on back of doll to activate toy.

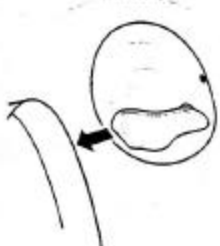
Doll will go into "sleep mode" after approximately 3 to 4 minutes of non-play. To re-animate doll, push button to "OFF" position, then push button once again to turn doll back on. Push button to "OFF" position if you expect to not play with the doll for an extended period of time. Take batteries out of doll in the event of an even longer period of non-play.



Clip controller to your waist and when you dance, Dancin' Debbi will dance. For best results, make sure the controller is clipped on horizontally straight as shown in the photo above.
