Distances are illustrated in the following Table. The equation and threshold in section 4.3.1 must be applied to determine SAR test exclusion.

## 2. EUT RF Exposure

The Max Conducted Peak Output Power is 3.74dBm (2.37mW) in 2402MHz of GFSK;

The antenna gain of this antenna is 3.46dBi.

3.46dB logarithmic terms convert to numeric result is nearly 2.22.

EIRP=  $P \times G = 2.37 \text{mW} \times 2.22 = 5.26 \text{ mW}.$ 

SAR requirement :S=10mw

EIRP < S

So the SAR report is not required.
