1. Concerning compliance with Part 15B as a PC peripheral, please be advised that the equipment covered in this application will not be offered for sale or ever distributed in the United States. In the past we have inquired with the FCC and received confirmation that the DoC for Part 15B is not necessary if the device is not marketed in the US.
2. The attached photo and engineering drawing shows the location, size, shape and material of the Bluetooth antenna. The gain is 0dBi.

You are listed as the Technical Contact for the above referenced TCB application. The following item(s) need(s) to be resolved before the review can be continued:

1. The label on this device does not address the Computer Peripheral operation of this device, since it connects to a computer. According to FCC 15.101, Computer Peripheral approval can either be by Declaration of Conformity (FCC Logo on the label) or by Certification (requires separate application, but can be under the same FCC ID). Please explain which approval process was used for the Computer Peripheral portion of this device and update any exhibits as necessary, or, as has been done in the past, indicate whether this device will ever be offered for sale in the United States. You have indicated before that in the past you have inquired with the FCC and received confirmation that the DoC for Part 15B is not necessary for this device if it is not marketed in the US.

2. The Model Description exhibit states that the Bluetooth Antenna is the same (or same type) as the GSM antenna. Please verify the antenna used for the Bluetooth Transmitter portion of this device and supply an antenna specification exhibit.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of the original e-mail date may result in application dismissal and forfeiture of the filing fee. Also, please note that partial responses increase processing time and should not be submitted.
