I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that you have marked several exhibits as temporary confidentiality but have not provided a request for temporary confidentiality. If temporary confidentiality is being requested, please provide the request letter and list each appropriate exhibit for which temporary confidentiality is being requested.
2. Please note that the tune up procedure required by the FCC is not dependent upon end user ability to tune the device nor is it dependent upon the ability of the integrator to tune the device. Please note that the tune up procedure required by the FCC in accordance with 47CFR2.1033 deals with the required factory alignment procedures. Please provide the factory tune up procedures for the GSM module.
3. Please note that the report lists GPRS and PCS1900. Please note that GMS and GPRS are both GXW emissions designators whereas EGPRS (Edge technology) is G7W. The 731 lists G7W as an emissions designator. Please confirm if the designation in the report "GPRS" is in fact EDGE technology (G7W). If it is, please correct the report to indicate EDGE G7W technology.
4. Please confirm if the GPRS listed in the SAR report is intended to indicate EDGE technology (G7W designator). If so. Please correct the report to properly indicate EDGE technology.
