Gentlemen:

Regarding the RPV599 Portable Transceiver currently being considered for certification, the following items apply.

RPV599 Series radios can be programmed in four different ways:

- A. With a computer, RELM's proprietary RPV599A editor software, and a PCRP interface cable.
- B. With the RPV599A's external controls.
- C. With a CCRP cloning cable, clone programmed settings from one RPV599A portable radio to another RPV599A.
- D. Wireless clone mode, clone programmed settings from one RPV599A portable radio to another RPV599A.

Programming software, accessories, and procedures are issued only to authorized distributors and repair facilities. The radio cannot be programmed for any frequency change, including channel spacing (12.5/15 kHz vs. 25/30 kHz), by a user in the field.
