These exhibits contain critical design information and are highly proprietary; they must not be made available for public inspection. This information is proprietary both to Alcatel-Lucent USA Inc. and to Alcatel-Lucent's contracted design manufacturers.

The document Alcatel-Lucent CDMA Base Stations Release 31.0 Operations, Administration and Maintenance, included in Exhibit 3, is not furnished to the user, except under very exceptional and very limited circumstances. These manuals contain highly proprietary circuit, equipment and architecture descriptions that must not be made available for public inspection. The cover/title page is explicitly labeled "*Unpublished and Not for Publication*". Therefore, it must not be made available for public inspection. The confidentiality request for UMTS Alcatel-Lucent 9341 Remote Radio Head, UMTS-5.1, Operation, Administration and Maintenance, 9341 RRH OA&M document, submitted in the initial FCC certification application for UMTS application under the AS5ONEBTS-19 was approved by the FCC on November 10, 2008.

The proprietary information contained in these exhibits is considered to be trade secrets and the property of Alcatel-Lucent USA Inc and its contracted design manufacturers, pursuant to the provisions of Section 0.457(d) of the Commission's Rules and Section 552(b)(4) of the Freedom of Information Act.
