We respectfully wish to apply for a Class II permissive change for the above referenced FCC Identifier under the provisions of FCC rule 2.1043.

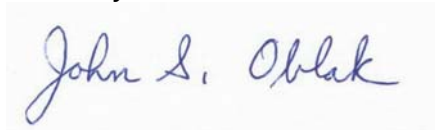
The changes that were made to the unit involve mechanical changes to accomplish several goals. The first is to provide for a more cost effective manufacture of the assembly by redesigning the plastic housing and die cast chassis parts, as well as sever smaller mechanical pieces. In addition, changes were made to enhance the environmental sealing to improve the resistance to water intrusion. In addition, several minor cosmetic changes were done. The electrical design and performance remains essentially the same as in the original submission. A SAR test report is included to support this request.

The applicant certifies that no party to this application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug abuse Act of 1988.
