





Plug the included 3.5mm audio cable into the IBomb Party and then connect your source (e.g: MP3 player, Tablet, Computer, etc.)

Short press to previous track Long press to fast backward



Short press to next track Long press to fast forward



Volume down



Vol+ Volume up





FAIL TO PAIR

TROUBLESHOOTING

Check that the speaker is in pairing mode.
Ensure your device is within Wireless use range.
Reset your device to activate Wireless. Ensure that your device is not connected /paired to any other Wireless devices as Wireless can only be paired to one device at a time.
