

# User Manual

## ADT-BSK09

### Introduction:

Thank you and congratulations! You own a super mini Bluetooth Speaker. You can use this speaker to listen to audio successfully and wirelessly from devices such as smart phones, computers, iPods, tablets and other Bluetooth sound sources.

### Components:

1. Mini Bluetooth Speaker
2. USB Charging Cable

### Specifications:

1. Weight: about 60g unit only
2. Battery life: 2~3 hours
3. AC adapter: DC(5V500-1000mA)
4. Bluetooth Range: 10M
5. Working Frequency Band: 2.4GHZ

### Precautions:

1. Read the user manual first before using your speaker.
2. Avoid striking and the risk of electric shock, do not use your speaker under high temperatures or undue humidity.
3. Please power your speaker off if it is exposed to water.
4. Please Do not open your speaker without the assistance of certified professionals.
5. Please unplug the AC power adapter from the power outlet and also disconnect it from your speaker while it is not used.

### Functions and Features

1. Mini appearance easy to take.
2. Supports Bluetooth V3.0/2.1.
3. AUX port allows you to connect additional audio sources by using the include 3.5mm Auxiliary cable.

### Charging

Connect one end of the USB charging cable to the charging Jack, then plug the other end of the USB charging cable to the USB charging Jack of your computer's available USB ports or AC adapter.

### Note:

- 1) The internal battery of your speaker takes approximately two to three hours to fully charge when completely drained.

- 2) When charging, a red LED light will illuminate, the red light will turn to blue LED after fully charge .

### **Audio Function**

AUX port allows you to connect audio sources using the 3.5mm Auxiliary Cable:

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm Auxiliary Cable to "AUX" Jack, then plug the other end into one of your Audio Jack.
2. Slide the switch to "🎧" position, a blue LED light will illuminate, simply start playing the music, movie or game, etc, then all the audio will automatically be played through "Coda Pop".
3. Slide the switch from "🎧" to "off" to turn off the Bluetooth speaker.

### **Bluetooth Function Setting:**

This Bluetooth Speaker allows you listen to audio successfully and wirelessly from your Bluetooth sound sources.

1. Slide the switch to the Bluetooth mark, you will hear an audio signal and see a blue LED light flash, it indicates that your speaker for Bluetooth function is powered on. One second later, a blue/red LED light flash alternately.
2. Switch on your Bluetooth device, find the Bluetooth Manager of your Bluetooth device, search and connect "Coda Pop", a signal "du" and blue LED light flash every 7 seconds remind your device and speaker pair each other successfully.
3. Start playing the music, movie or game, etc by your device, under this condition, all the audio will automatically be played through "Coda Pop".
4. The next time, your Bluetooth device and speaker are in range of each other, and the Bluetooth feature is turned on, they should automatically connect.
5. Slide the switch from Bluetooth mark to "off" to turn off the Bluetooth speaker.

*Note:* The Bluetooth speaker will automatically connect to the Bluetooth device on condition that no any other Bluetooth device is connected your speaker.

### **How to Pair other Bluetooth Device**

1. Make sure no any other Bluetooth device is connected your speaker.
2. Go to the Bluetooth Manager of your another Bluetooth device.
3. Search and connect "Coda Pop", then your device and speaker will automatically pair each other.

*Note:* Please make sure your speaker is restarted before you search and connect your device to your speaker.

### **How to use the Bluetooth function of phone conversation**

1. Connect your smart phone with your Bluetooth speaker  
(Regarding part **Bluetooth Function Setting**).
2. Pick up the call and adjust the conversation mode to Bluetooth mode by phone,

about 2 seconds later, you will hear and answer your phone through the speaker.

*Note:* Function is valid within Bluetooth range
